COUNTRY GENTLEMAN RUNS WRITE-UP

Contributor to Clubs Department Puts Cove in Limelight

The Country Gentleman, published by the Curtis concern, gives Cove some desirable publicity in its current issue. Under its Clubs department, the magazine carries an article from L. M. L., which goes on to say:

The Cove Canners
"Cove's got 'em" Canning Club was organized July 12, 1915, at Cove, Oregon, with five members, all under eighteen years of age. The club was organized through the influence of Union County Agriculturist, C. C. Cate.

The girls had a very successful first season. They have been learning to do canning of all kinds in a more economical way, putting up the best grade, and doing the work quickly. They have used a steam-pressure canner furnished by Mr. Cate, but they are planning before another year to have a canner of their own and do work for the community wherever they can, thus earning something for themselves and at the same time helping out busy farm wives. At the Union County fair there was a canning demonstration under the supervision of the Oregon Agricultural College. Three canning clubs of the county worked for the prize. The Cove Club tied for first honors with one other, thus winning twenty dollars.

The girls while working are also enjoying themselves, making work seem play. Cove is the cherry town of Eastern Oregon, and for the Cherry Fair, "Cove's got 'em" was the slogan adopted by the community.

In the picture with the girls is the county agriculturist, the canner in operation, and some tin cans filled ready for the canner. While their work has been almost entirely with glass jars, they expect to use the tin cans also. L. M. L.
