Sherry Theater Today
Madame X has made her screen debut. Alexander Bisson's great drama will be presented in pictures by Pathe at Sherry's today and tomorrow.

Miss Donnelly's magnificent interpretation on the stage of the woman who drifted in search of love is duplicated on the screen. The skill with which Miss Donnelly handles the difficult role is an artistic revelation. There are no sudden transformations from the normal to the degraded—no lapse of years to obviate the necessity for subtle changes in appearance and action. The play goes on from scene to scene, and as time elapses and the woman becomes more and more abandoned, there are slight, almost imperceptible changes in her appearance; a new wrinkle, a droop of the shoulders, a hardening about the mouth, a furtive look in the eyes that speak eloquently the weakness of the character and the artistry of its interpreter. But for all falling from grace, there is something so exquisitely pathetic in this woman's blind groping for the beautiful that one forgets to feel about her, and feels with her in all the poignant incidents of her emotion-racked career.

THE MILLIONAIRE CROP

And Other Notes From the World's Metropolis—New York.

New York, March 16.—The personal tax rolls for the city of New York, which have just been made public, contains six new names out of a total of seven, who have been assessed as being possessors of personal property exceeding one million dollars. Last fall almost six hundred residents were added as millionaires by the city officials, and for weeks the offices of the tax department were thronged with men and women who either were seeking to clear themselves of the imputation of wealth laid against them or to find out where their property was located. The city will collect this year on \$24,478,396 more of personal property than it did in 1933. It is estimated that the receipts will amount to more than \$2,500,000 over last year, or an increase of 40 per cent. The total assessments of personal property this year amount to \$276,588,339. To the personal property assessment is added the real estate and corporation assessments, and from the total the city's tax rate for the current year is computed. The real estate valuation shows a total of \$5,207,822,361, an increase over the preceding year of \$69,061,574, the grand total for the city being \$8,584,352,511, an increase over 1933 of \$125,458,519.

Three solid trainloads of sugar filling 198 cars and comprising the first transcontinental shipment of raw cane sugar that has ever been received in the New York market has just reached this city. Owing to the slides in the Panama canal, the steamship company which has the contract for forwarding Hawaiian cane sugar from Honolulu to the eastern seaboard, has decided to transport all sugars from Hawaii at San Francisco by rail to New York and Philadelphia. These shipments for the year will amount to 250,000 tons, and the first of these, amounting to nearly 8,000 tons has just arrived. It is estimated that the value of this shipment is over three quarters of a million dollars. While several shipments of California beet sugar have been received in the eastern market at different times, this is the first time in the history of the sugar trade that raw cane sugar has been shipped across the United States by rail to compete with the foreign grown sugar of Cuba.
