City Manager's Report.

There were no fires last week. The police had eight sleepers. The pound master had five cows in the pound for which \$5.00 pound fees were paid the city.

Tech street department expended \$79.56 for teams and drivers; \$46.50 for wages; \$15.00 for white wing; \$25.57 for cross walk lumber; \$18.15 for crushed rock used last week; \$3.95 for a keg of nails and \$1.00 for repairing lubricator. Cleaned, repaired and rolled East Adams, cleaned north Fir, laid a cross walk on Greenwood and Jackson, an alley walk on Third between B and C avenues, and flushed and cleaned down town streets.

The water department spent \$34.50 during the week. About half of this was spent installing three three-fourths inch taps and one, one and a fourth inch tap with three three-fourths inch meters. The balance was expended repairing meter boxes and connections.

The recorder collected \$5.00 pound fees; \$2.00 building permits and \$6.00 dog licenses. On treasurer's receipts he issued \$95.00 pool licenses; \$25.00 pop corn; \$20.00 electrical and \$10.00 dray licenses. He issued a warrant on the park fund for \$32.39 on voucher No. 59 and for \$50.00 on voucher No. 57. He issued \$1142.64 salary and \$866.78 labor warrants and \$24.66 light bill on city building.

The treasurer collected \$812.50 water rent; \$726.26 improvement district installments; \$322.72 improvement district interest; \$3.55 principal district No. 88; 85 cents interest district No. 92; \$20.00 electrical license; \$10.00 dray license; \$95.00 pool license; \$25.00 pop corn license and \$2666.32 taxes from the county treasurer. He paid \$238.63 water warrants; \$645.19 road warrants; \$82.39 park warrants; \$9.90 improvement district interest and \$3517.60 general warrants with \$446.76 interest on same.

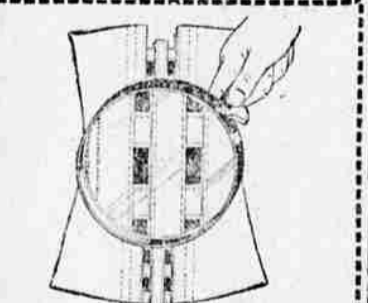
