LUMBER TO NEW YORK.
Order for a Million Feet to Be Shipped by Rail.
Portland, April 12.—One million feet of heavy construction timber is being shipped to New York from Portland by Sullivan & Forbes, wholesale lumber dealers of this city and New York.
The material will make the journey across the continent by rail and the freight rate on this class is \$24.75 a thousand feet. The fact that the consumers are willing to pay the rail rate is taken as indicative of the strong demand for large timbers on the Atlantic coast.
With the opening of the Panama canal it is expected that a large business in Douglas fir on the Atlantic coast will be worked up providing vessels are obtainable.

MODERN DRESS ROILS SMITH

CHURCH HEAD ATTACKS FASHIONS BITTERLY.

Thanks God His Own Daughters Haven't Adopted New Fashions

Many Union county people will read with interest the text of President Joseph F. Smith's attack on modern dress for women, given at the closing session of the recent L. D. S. conference in Salt Lake. The Deseret News covers the attack in these words:

Seathing denunciation by Pres. Joseph F. Smith of the prevailing fashions in women's dress, together with vehement reproof for the "daughters of Zion" that permit themselves to be led into "imitation of the garb of the demi-monde" constituted a dramatic conclusion last night of the semi-annual conference of the Deseret Sunday School Union. In an assembly that filled to capacity the tabernacle, including the choir seats, Pres. Smith pronounced the late fashions for women the "products of houses of infamy," and pleaded with the girls and women of the church to refrain from their adoption.

Following his regular closing address at the conference, in which he had declared the gathering the largest in the history of the Sunday School movement, Pres. Smith begged indulgence to touch upon a topic foreign to Sunday School affairs. Without further preliminaries, he launched upon an arraignment of modern fashions, declaring himself ashamed of them, and adding that their creation was wholly for the purpose of inviting licentiousness and for the gratification of the lust of scoundrels who stand ready to defile anything and everything sacred.

"You will pardon me if I speak for a moment on a topic entirely foreign to Sunday School work and Sunday School subjects," said Pres. Smith after concluding his remarks about the progress of the Sunday School movement. "I wish to enter my protest against the prevailing fashions for women. Fashions that are not only ridiculous but shameful, suggestive and disgraceful to the modesty of men who have any regard for themselves and womankind.

"To say that I am ashamed of the clothing of some of the daughters of Zion is to speak my mind mildly. I know I stand condemned by those that love the fashions of Babylon.

"The fashions worn by some of our women today had their origin in the houses of infamy in Paris and London and other great centers. Innocent people here and elsewhere fall into the habit of imitating those fallen, infamous women in their manners of dress, creatures who live by enticing the lust of men. Our girls have not wisdom enough to stop imitating these creatures, and many of them are wearing the fashions created for the gratification of the lust of scoundrels that stand ready at any time to defile everything sacred.

"I enter my protest against my daughters following such fashions, and I thank God that thus far none of them have. I pray that our other girls and women may refrain from adopting them also."
