AT ARCADE.
 "Pudd'nhead Wilson."
 Theodore Roberts, the popular Lasky star, will be seen at the Arcade Friday and Saturday in the title role of Mark Twain's famous story "Pudd'nhead Wilson," under the direction of the Jesse L. Lasky Feature Play Co.

IMPROVE TROPICAL PICTURES
 "The Ruling Passion" Solves Climate Problem.
 Perfect motion picture photography

in the burning climate of the tropics has long presented an insurmountable problem to photoplay manufacturers, who, however anxious they might be to present as backgrounds the exotic foliage and wonderful scenery to be found in the region of the equator, were compelled to photograph, if they desired ideal results, more familiar scenes because of the climatic conditions found in hot countries. The highly important and interesting question of good photography in countries where the normal temperature hovers around the fever mark, was solved in the making of the William Fox production, "The Ruling Passion," in Jamaica. The film was developed in special laboratories erected for the purpose.

One of the most important things learned concerning the making of motion pictures in tropical climates has to do with the shipping of the raw film from the point of production. If raw film is shipped from the manufacturer already perforated, with its sprocket holes bored, it will have a tendency to shrink, as the air of the tropics is almost certain to penetrate the shipping can, no matter how apparently secure the same may be sealed. For producing a film which will permit of perfect projection, the perforation should be made upon the spot when working in tropical climates, as was done in the film used in "The Ruling Passion." Otherwise the shrinkage of the film will cause unsteadiness when the picture is projected on the screen. Last day at Sherry's today.

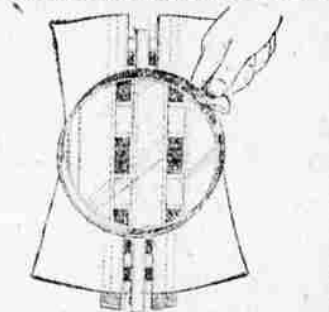

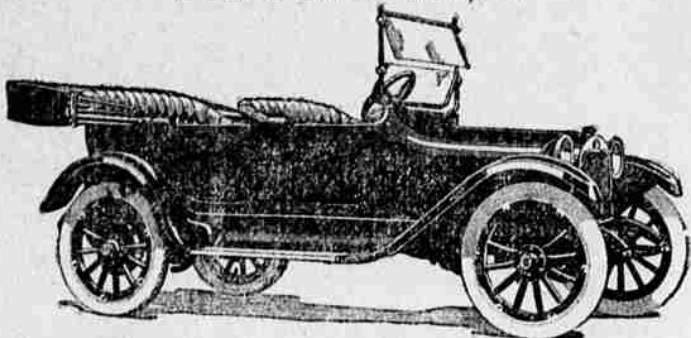
