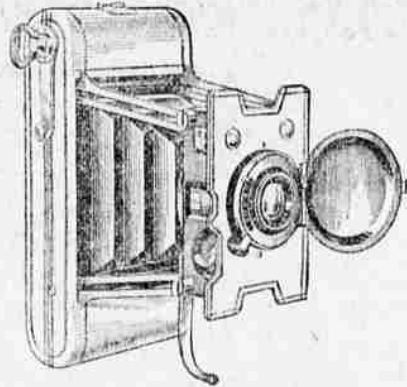

known. She was formerly principal of the Pilot Rock schools and two years ago was principal of the Lincoln school of this city. She is a sister of Mrs. G. W. Rugg.

Her opponent in the primaries will be G. W. Bradley, the present incumbent, and, if she wins, she will be opposed at the general election by Oliver Dickenson of Athena, or H. J. Stillman of this city, who are seeking the Democratic nomination.
