Davenport of Oklahoma today donned a pair of blue overalls and hied away across the river from Washington to cultivate a seven-acre farm and practice on the government's seed crop. Associated with him in cultivation of the festive soy bean and the gamboling cow pea is J. S. Coffman, an old time employee of the government printing office, who owns the farm. Possessed of the idea that those numerous packages of seeds which the government sends out at the request of "your congressman" maybe grow turnips instead of Early Spring radishes, cauliflower instead of frost-proof cabbages, and spinach instead of Golden Head Lettuce, Congressman Davenport has started this practical test within the shadows of the capitol. It might be that they are good vote-getters and again, a constituent expecting to raise a crop of rutabagas surely would be irritated to find parsnips instead.

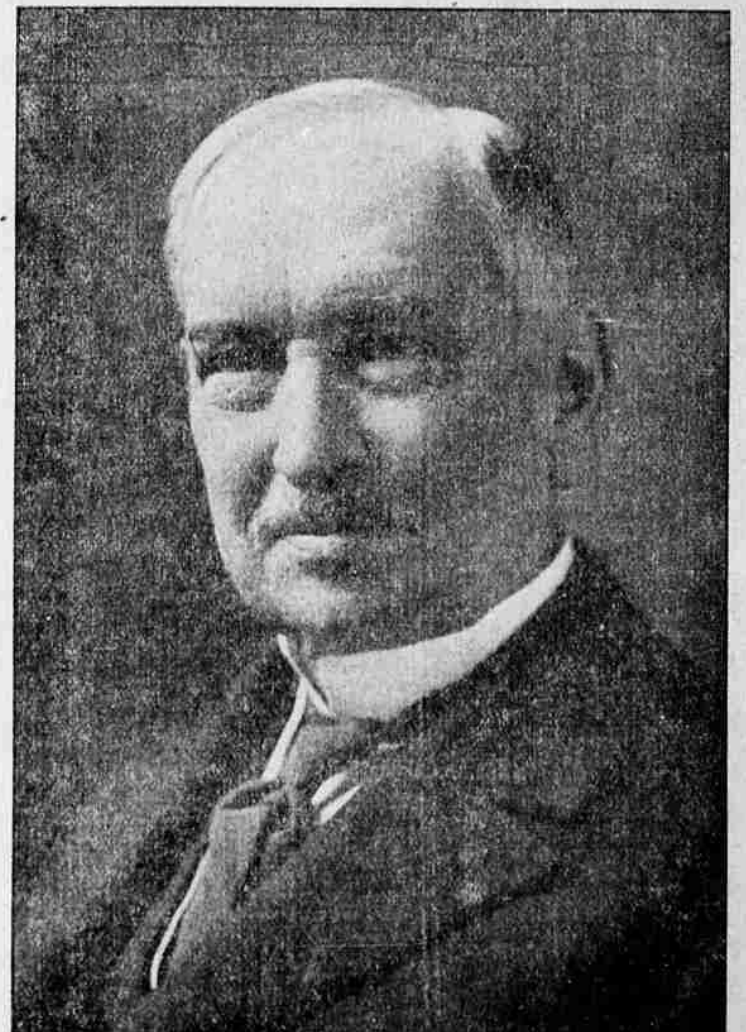
