Raymond Hitchcock in "Stolen Magic"

Admirers of the delightfully satirical art of Raymond Hitchcock, who enjoyed his work in the Sennett-Keystone comic thriller "My Valet," will be pleased to learn that he will be seen at the Arcade tonight and tomorrow in an entirely different humorous two-reeler, which, like the other, also enlists the personal talents of Mark Sennett and Mabel Normand.

An "Arabian Nights" tale brought up to date and Keystonized in the way "Stolen Magic" is described. Mr. Hitchcock is a delver in magic who arrives at the home of a friend with an enchanted scroll and a suit case full of snakes. An oriental, from whom the scroll has been stolen, pur-

AT SHERRY'S

E. Forrest Taylor, star in the Mutual Masterpicture De Luxe Edition "True Nobility," a five act drama which will be seen at the Sherry theatre, has gained a wide reputation as a delineator of Western types. He is noted for his remarkable talent for strong dramatic interpretation of virred blooded types of real men.

Mr. Taylor's advent into moving pictures is unique among film stars. While a college student in the prominent Western college he was given an opportunity with several of his friends to appear as extras in some moving

picture scenes being taken in the town where the college was located. The spirit of the players and the outdoor work in connection with picture acting appealed to him so much that upon leaving college he applied for a permanent place in a picture comedy.

Sem Lew, Baker Pioneer, Dead.

Lying on a lounge and dressed at his home, 1724 Center street, a neighbor, Thomas J. Temple, found Samuel Lew dead. The deceased had been in poor health for several years.

Mr. Lew was a native of Clark's Mill, Canada, born May 5, 1839, and in 1873 came to Baker with his wife, lately deceased, to reside. He was by trade a carpenter and for many years was one of the town's principal building contractors. He later engaged in the furniture business and at one time he was very well to do financially. Later, reverses came and he tried mining with poor success.

His relatives in this country are a granddaughter, Enid Lew, of Thermo, California, four nephews, George, John, Frank and Albert Lew of this city and vicinity, and a niece, Mrs. J. Kelly of Powder River valley.

Large Purchase of Timber.

Baker, May 2.—Manager Frank Gardinier of the Baker White Pine Lumber company yesterday reported the purchase by his company from the Wallowa Timber company of approximately 20,000 acres of timber land in Baker and Grant counties in the vicinity of Whitney. This purchase will probably mean the erection of another large mill here, according to Mr. Gardinier, if certain concessions in the way of vacating certain streets and alleys for switches, etc., can be secured. The sum involved in the deal was not mentioned.

The company is negotiating for another large body of pine, says Mr. Gardinier, that may mean the location of a mill at Durkee, if the company cannot secure the concessions desired in Baker.

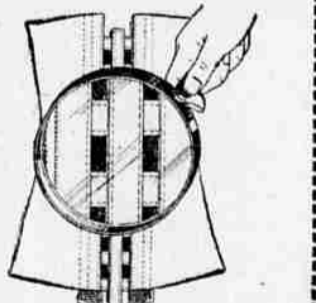
