SOCIALIST CONVICTED

Jury Finds Him Guilty of Libeling Washington.

Tacoma, Wash., May 4.—A verdict of guilty was returned last night by the superior court jury that for four days has been sitting in the trial of Paul H. Haffer, a young Tacoma Socialist, accused of libeling the memory of George Washington. Attorneys say the case sets a precedent for the entire country. The maximum penalty for the offense, under a statute, is one year in the county jail, a fine of \$1000, or both. Less than two

hours were required to reach a verdict. A new trial will be asked and an appeal will be taken to the state supreme court, it was announced if this is denied.

Colonel Albert E. Joab, an attorney, who caused Haffer's arrest after the latter had sent a letter to a newspaper referring to Washington as a "blasphemer," "slave holder" and "inveterate drinker," warmly shook the hand of each juror, exclaiming fervently, "God bless you."
