Sheepshead Bay Scene of Unique Experiments During The Day

New York, May 6.—An aeroplane thriller will be staged at the Sheepshead Bay Speedway when Aviator Thompson, who "bombed" New York and Washington from the air will drop bombs on the silhouette of a battle cruiser, will chase an armed auto equipped with a rapid fire gun, and after his loop-the-loop, cork-screw slide and upside down fight will impersonate a wounded aviator, taking both hands and feet from the controls and tumbling to within 200 feet of the ground. He will also race four miles with Dario Resta in his Peugeot car, keeping ten feet above the track all the way. In addition there will be a fight between two aeroplanes, each carrying observers with machine guns. Henry Woodhouse of the Aero club planned the educational exhibition.

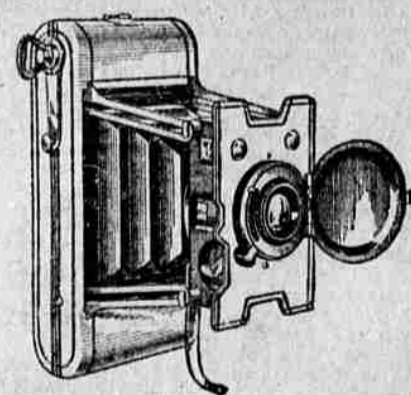
