NOTICE OF THE RECORDER of the City of La Grande, Oregon, of the Re-Assessment of Improvement District No. 54 of the City of La Grande, Oregon.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Re-Assessment for the improvement heretofore made of South Fourth Street from the south property line of O. Avenue, formerly O. Street, in Chaplin's Addition to the town of La Grande, Union County, Oregon to the north property line of C. Avenue, formerly C. Street, in the town of La Grande, Union County, Oregon, under the provisions of Ordinance Number 824, Series 1916. "An Ordinance approving the re-assessment made and filed by the Recorder of the City of La Grande on March 8th, 1916 for the cost of the improvement of Fourth Street in Re-Assessment District Number Fifty-four, from the south property line of O Avenue, formerly O. Street, in Chaplin's Addition to the town of La Grande, Union County, Oregon, to the north property line of C Avenue, formerly C. Street, in the town of La Grande, Union County, Oregon, as modified and corrected by the Commission of the City of La Grande by Resolution of said Commission of April 28th, 1916; levying an assessment upon the property in said

re-assessment district number fifty-four, benefited by such improvement; providing for an assessment roll for such re-assessment and directing the entry of the assessment by this Ordinance levied on the Bond Lien Docket of the City; providing when said assessment shall become delinquent; and providing for the payment of said assessments and interest thereon in installments, the same being in improvement District No. 54, in said City of La Grande, Oregon, is now in my hands for collection and the same may be paid to me at any time within ten (10) days from the 8th day of May, 1916, without penalty, interest or cost; and each owner or reputed owner is hereby notified that on application to the undersigned within ten (10) days from the 8th day of May, 1916, which is the first date of the publication of this notice, they will be allowed to pay such assessment in ten (10) annual installments, the first installment thereof being due and payable on or before the 8th day of May, 1917. If application is not made as above specified, the whole amount is due, payable and will become delinquent on the 20th day of May, 1916. The assessment roll is as follows:

Track Team Leaves for Annual Classic This Evening.

Baker high is not alone in grief on the eve of the annual Eastern Oregon track and field meet, to be held at Baker tomorrow. Millering, crack hurdler, pole vaulter and relay man, has been banned from participation. The faculty is disciplining him and there will be no Millering in tomorrow's competitors from La Grande. This loss is a heavy one but is part of the system that makes for order and discipline in public schools.

Jess Andrews, student body manager, went to Baker today noon to look after preliminaries and the team and coach follow him tonight and the team members will be: Conkey, Larson, H. Moon, E. Moon, Ingle, Reynolds, Adeok, Carroll, Huff, Bradley, Bean and Hopkins.

The Pendleton high school track team members were passengers on today's noon train for Baker where they are favorites in tomorrow's meet. The La Grande squad goes tonight in charge of Coach Reynolds, and tomorrow the team supporters will take various trains to Baker and return Saturday night or Sunday morning.

Pendleton has won the annual event for the past two years, winning last year from La Grande by one point. Coach Gordon believes that he has a better team this year than last and it is confident that his men will win by several points. About twenty schools will be represented in the meet.
