JUNE 4-5-6 SHOOT DATES

PORTLAND EXPECTS GREAT DISPLAY OF TALENT.

Blue Rock Contests at Portland on Money-Back Basis.

Portland, Ore., May 26.—Eyes of sportsmen of the Pacific Coast and Northwest are centered on the Everding Park traps of the Portland Gun club where the 33d annual tournament of the Sportsmen's association of the Northwest will be staged June 4, 5, 6 and 7. Transshotters from California, Washington, Idaho, Montana and Oregon will participate.

To take care of the record-breaking number of shooters expected, the club has installed four of the latest trap houses. They are made of concrete and each will hold 30,000 targets.

The feature of this season's tournament will be the "For You a Rose in Portland Grows" event of 100 targets. This will be shot in five events of 20 birds each. W. J. Houser of Pomeroy, Wash., won the event last year with a score of 99 out of a possible 100.

Officials have decided to shoot the regular events under the Squier money-back system, which has become popular with the shooters. The trophy events, nine in number, will be shot under the yardage handicap system.

The first day's program will consist of 10 events of 15 birds each from the 16 yard line and three trophy events. The second day's program will be the same, and on the last day the Rose Festival event of 100 targets and three trophy events, including the three-men team race, will be staged. Sunday, June 4, will be practice day. Rates are being given on all railroads.
