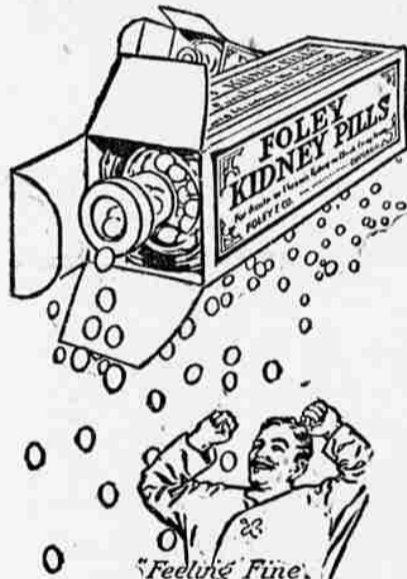

Sporting News

University of Oregon, Eugene, May 30.—With a great "osky wow" and a promise to be back on the campus promptly in September for fall training, the crack University of Oregon football team disbanded for the summer at the end of a banquet attended by 35 members of the squad. Under the rules of the new Pacific Coast Intercollegiate conference, the University of Oregon, University of Washington and O. A. C. may not begin fall training prior to September 12, and the University of California may not begin until its first semester has opened.

University of Oregon men face a hard schedule of seven games next fall, of which the last five are major games. The schedule follows: Willamette university at Salem, October 7; Multnomah A. A. Club at Eugene, October 14; University of California at Berkeley, October 21; University of Washington at Eugene, November 4; Washington State College at Portland, November 11; O. A. C. at Corvallis, November 25; Multnomah A. A. Club at Portland, Thanksgiving day.

Coch Benick loses only three players by graduation this year, Anson Cornell and James Cossman, but Lyle Bigbee, who has become a professional baseball player, and one or two others who may have to stay out next year to earn money, will also be lost. The year's athletics shows a deficit of about \$500, and the student body will owe from \$700 to \$900 at the beginning of the next semester. It owed \$2500, however, in September, 1914. This year's slight deficit was

caused by bad weather at the O. A. C. game and the cancellation of the game with Washington; otherwise there would have been a substantial profit.

Delayed Mails Sent to Yukon River

Seattle, May 26.—The steamship Jefferson sailed for Skagway today with a large amount of second and third class mail which has accumulated at the Seattle postoffice since last November and addressed to points on the Yukon river below White Horse. During the winter only first class mail is sent to points on the frozen river below the railroad terminus.

Destructive Hailstorm in Lane

Junction City, Or., May 26.—Late Wednesday afternoon a hailstorm passed just north of this place and fell to the depth of one inch, beating down a large acreage of vetch and clover and doing considerable damage to the young hop vines that were yet tender and just starting up the poles.
