Notice of Sewer Construction and Assessment.

Notice is hereby given to all whom it may concern that the Commission of the City of La Grande, Union County, Oregon, proposes and intends to improve Section Five of Sewer District Number Three of the City of La Grande by constructing therein a sanitary sewer and that the report of the Committee on Estimates appointed under and by resolution of the Commission of said City of date April 26, 1916, has made its report in writing to the Commission which report was on the 19th of May, 1916, finally approved and adopted by the Commission of said City and said Commission has set Wednesday, the 14th day of June, A. D. 1916 at 7:30 o'clock P. M. at the Commission room in the City Building in La Grande, Oregon, as the time and place when the Commission will meet, hear and determine all objections, remonstrances and claims of grievance of persons interested therein and affected thereby. That the boundaries of the said District to be so improved, as finally adopted by said Commission is as follows: Commencing at the center of Block Nineteen, in Coggan's Addition to La Grande, Oregon, and running thence west along the center line of said Block Nineteen and along the center lines of Blocks 54, 53, 52 and 51 of Chaplin's Addition to the Town of La Grande, Union County, Oregon, to the center of Fourth Street in said Chaplin's Addition; thence south along

the center line of said Fourth Street to a point 120 feet south of the south property line of L. Avenue of said Chaplin's Addition; thence west to the center of First Street in said Chaplin's Addition; thence south along the center line of First Street to a point thereon west of the center of Block 86 of said Chaplin's Addition; thence east through the center of said Block 86 of said Addition to the center line of Second Street in said Chaplin's Addition; thence south along the center line of Second Street to the center line of I Street, now known and described as I Avenue, in said Chaplin's Addition; thence east 18 feet to the center of the inter-sections of Second Street and said I Avenue; thence south along the center of Second Street in said Addition to the center line of H. Avenue; thence east seven feet; thence south along the center line of said Second Street in Arnold & Dray's Addition to a point thereon opposite the center line of Block Nine in Arnold & Dray's Addition to the Town of La Grande, Union County, Oregon; thence east along the center line of Blocks Nine and Ten of said Arnold & Dray's Addition, and the center line of Blocks twenty-two, twenty-one, twenty-three and twenty-four of said Chaplin's Addition to a point 60 feet east of the east property line of Seventh Street in said Chaplin's Addition, and thence north to the center of the alley in Block Thirty-four of said Chaplin's Addition opposite the northeast corner of Lot Twelve in said Block Thirty-four; thence east along the center line of the alley in said Block Thirty-four to the center of Eighth Street in said Chaplin's Addition, and thence north along the center line of said Eighth Street to the center line of the alley running east and west through Block Thirty-seven, of said Chaplin's Addition; thence west along the center line of said alley to a point thereon opposite the northeast corner of Lot 12 in said Block 37; thence north to the center of the alley in Block 47 of said Chaplin's Addition to a point opposite the northeast corner of Lot 12 in said Block 47; thence east along the center line of said alley to the center of Eighth Street in said Chaplin's Addition; thence north along the center line of said Eighth Street to the center of L. Street in said Chaplin's Addition, now known as L. Avenue, thence East along the center line of said L. Street in said Addition to a point thereon opposite the center line running north and south through Block Nineteen of said Coggan's Addition and thence north along the center line of said Block Nineteen of said Coggan's Addition to the point of beginning.

That said District is to be improved by the construction therein of a sanitary sewer in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor heretofore adopted by the Commission as follows, to-wit: To construct an eight inch vitrified sewer with manholes and connections, along the center line of L. Avenue, formerly L. Street in Chaplin's Addition to the town of La Grande, Union County, Oregon, from a point 70 feet east of the east property line of Fourth Street in said Addition to the center of the inter-section of said L. Avenue and Eighth Street in said Addition; thence north along the center line of said Eighth Street to a connection with the present sewer at the inter-section of M. Avenue, formerly M. Street, and Eighth Street in said Addition and from the intersection of K. Avenue, formerly K. Street, and First Street in said Chaplin's Addition, along the center line of said K. Avenue to the center of the inter-section of said K. Avenue and Seventh Street in said Addition and from the center of the intersection of J. Avenue, formerly J. Street, and Second Street in said Chaplin's Addition, along the center line of said J. Avenue to the center of the intersection of said J. Avenue and Seventh Street in said Addition, and from the center of the inter-section of Second Street and I. Avenue, formerly I. Street, in said Addition, along the center line of said I. Avenue to the center of the intersection of said I. Avenue and Seventh Street in said Chaplin's Addition, and from the center of the inter-section of Second Street and H. Avenue, formerly H. Street, in said Chaplin's Addition, along the center line of said H. Avenue, to the center of the intersection of said H. Avenue and Seventh Street in said Addition, and from the center of the intersection of Second Street and G. Avenue (formerly G. Street) in Arnold & Dray's Addition to the Town of La Grande, Union County, Oregon, along the center line of G. Avenue to the center of the inter-section of said G. Avenue in Chaplin's Addition to the inter-section of said G. Avenue (formerly G. Street) and Seventh Street in said Chaplin's Addition, and an eight-inch vitrified sewer with manholes and connections from the center of the inter-section of K. Avenue and Seventh Street to the center of the inter-section of J. Avenue and Seventh Street, and a ten-inch vitrified sewer with manholes and connections from the center of the inter-section of J. Avenue, formerly J. Street, and Seventh Street to the center of the inter-section of I. Avenue and said Seventh Street and a twelve-inch vitrified sewer from the center of the inter-section of said I. Avenue and said Seventh Street to the center of the inter-section of said G. Avenue and said Seventh Street and a twelve-inch vitrified sewer from the center of the inter-section of I. Avenue and Seventh Street in said Chaplin's Addition, to the center of the inter-section of Eighth Street and said I. Avenue in said Chaplin's Addition, with the necessary manholes and connections, together with the necessary excavations therefor.
