DOG IS WITHOUT COUNTRY. Nelly, Ship's Mascot, Travels Back and Fourth on Ocean.

New York, June 6.—On the Cunarder Alauinia, which arrived here from London for the second time since the outbreak of the war, came a veritable dog of war, with a short pedigree and a long record as ship's mascot. The Alauinia has been engaged as a transport, making four trips to the Dardanelles from England, carrying 2800 each time; one voyage to India and the last one to Bussorah, in the Persian Gulf, with 2300 infantry to reinforce the British expedition against the Turks.

Nelly, the brown sheep dog mascot, has had an exciting career. When the war started Nelly heard the sound of the fife and drum and followed a Kentish infantry brigade to Boulogne. At the battle of Mons Nelly became separated from her

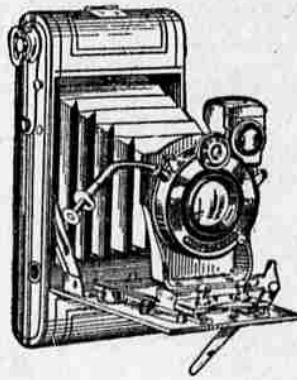
