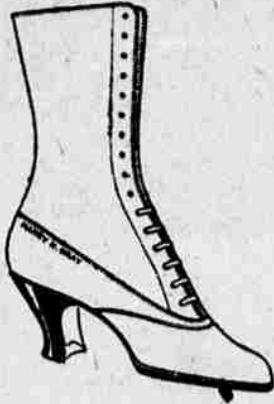

5000 Cattle Seen in Fox Film.
 One of the most striking and realistic western scenes ever filmed was taken by Raoul A. Walsh, director of the Fox Film Corporation, in producing the new western drama, "Blue Blood and Red." Walsh brought his company to New Mexico from California in order to take an actual round-up in which more than 5000 cattle were "cut out."

Moving the company of 80 players and the expense incidental to the change in program in taking the round-up parts of the picture added more than \$10,000 to the cost of the production.

It is a typically western drama that Mr. Walsh has prepared for the screen; one which will abound with thrills and be fraught with the atmosphere of the plains. It had not been Mr. Walsh's plan, however, to take the company to New Mexico, as a "location" had been decided upon in southern California near the Mexican border.

But the opportunity of catching the actual round-up of 5000 cattle came and in less than four hours after he heard of it, Mr. Walsh and his company were on their way to Albuquerque, near which city the great drive of "cows" is taking place.

Imprisonment For Debt.

About the middle of the last century the power of imprisoning a debtor for life was taken from the creditor, and it fills one with amazement to think that a system so ridiculous should have continued as long as it did. The three principal debtors' prisons in England were the King's Bench, the Marshalsea and the Borough Compter. In the year 1750 there were 20,000 prisoners for debt in Great Britain and Ireland. The utility of the system was quite as great as its barbarity. More than half the prisoners in some of the prisons were kept there solely because they could not pay the attorneys' costs. Many prisoners had their wives and children with them. There was no infirmary, no resident surgeon and no bath.—Dundee Advertiser.
