Railway Tunnel Burns.  
Bellingham, Wash., June 15.—Fire yesterday destroyed 250 feet of the Bellingham & Northern railway tunnel half a mile east of Deming, on the branch line the company is constructing between Gashen and Welcome. The damage is estimated at \$40,000 and will delay opening of the new line at least 60 days. The timber lining of the tunnel caught fire from the sparks from a steam shovel which was working inside removing a small slide. Firemen were sent from Bellingham to assist in fighting the fire.

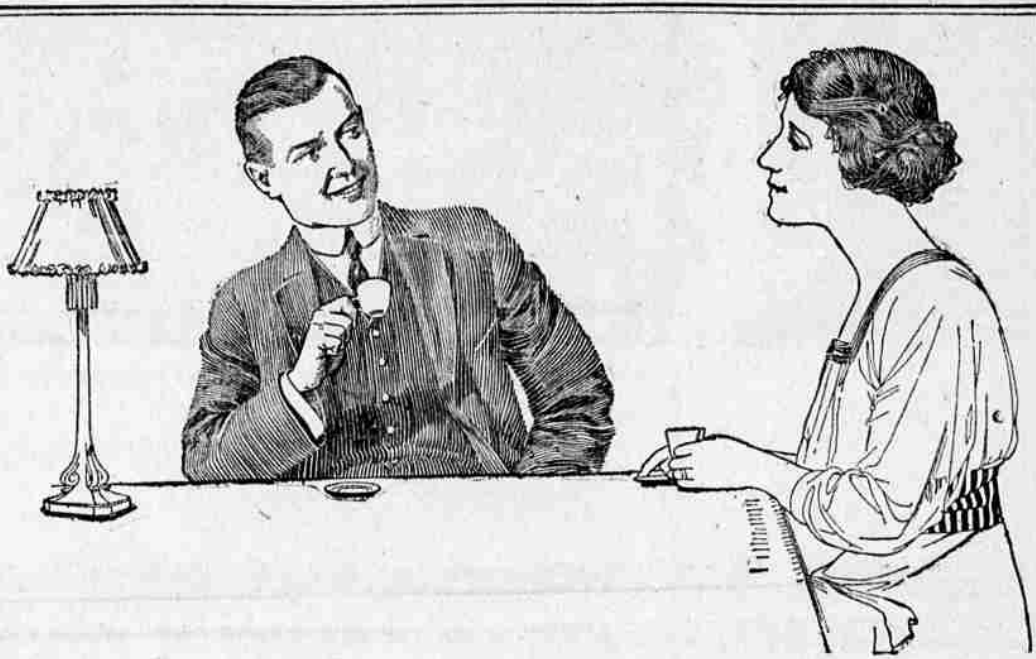
