## ORCHARDISTS WILL CONFER

COLLEGE EXPERTS TO ADDRESS FRUITMEN.  
Meetings in Imbler and Cove Set for Last of the Present Month.

An organization of fruit men of Union county is called to convene at Imbler June 26, La Grande June 27, and Cove June 28. These meetings arranged by County Agriculturist Paul H. Spillman, will be held for the purpose of considering methods of improving the marketing conditions by the adoption of the plan known as the uniform contract system of planning of marketing developed by specialists of the U. S. Bureau of Organization and Markets. The speakers for these meetings will be J. C. Skinner, editor of the Portland Fruit Marketer, G. L. Hurd, representative of the Agricultural College Bureau of Organization and Markets, and W. S. Brown, representing the College Extension service.

These meetings are held with a view to interest growers in the government plan of marketing horticultural products by the uniform contract plan. The plan is the result of investigational work carried on by United States government experts during the last two years. It contemplates the uniform marketing of horticultural products by all growers of the four northwestern states, Montana, Idaho, Washington and Oregon. Excellent progress has been made in the three former states and the work of organizing the fruit growers of Oregon is proceeding vigorously.

According to this plan the Growers' association and the selling agency all sign a uniform contract. This provides for uniform business procedure and system of accounting designed to permit the grower to make a correct comparison of the efficiency of the marketing methods of his district with that of other districts. This will be accomplished through a system of market reports made possible through the assistance offered by the United States government. The full details of the plan for improving the marketing conditions of horticultural crops will be explained by Mr. Skinner.

Professor Brown will explain the methods of the physical handling of the fruit in order to comply with the requirements of the plan. This will include the time of packing, orchard management at harvest time, essentials of a community packing plant, necessary equipment, the standardized pack and proper storage.

The advantages of co-operative over individual marketing methods will be explained by Professor Hurd, who will also assist the growers in effecting the organization. Mr. Hurd will explain the essentials for successful co-operation, name the most frequently encountered obstacles, and show how best to avoid them. He will also suggest types of organization and submit by-laws. He will explain the methods of incorporation and outline some of the features of association management. He will further show that by a comprehensive study of co-operation in the local community associations it will be possible for the grower readily to understand the system of co-operation amongst the growers of the four states.

Marines Have Pulling Powers.  
Port Royal, S. C., June 21.—After 14 weeks of military training in the open, a company of fifty-six recruits of the United States Marine Corps, learning the ropes at the recruit depot here, increased its pulling power from 202,198 pounds to 264,568 pounds—an increase of 63,370 pounds. Tests were made with Dr. Kellogg's dynamometer, a machine which automatically registers the exact number of pounds pulled by each muscle group of the body.
