ALCOHOL SALE TO BE CHECKED

PENDLETON DRUGGISTS SELL ONLY BY ORDER.
Council Passes Resolution by Request to This Effect.

Pendleton, July 14.—Acting upon a petition signed by the Tallman Drug Co., Koeppe Bros., and the Red Cross Drug Store, the city council last evening passed an ordinance prohibiting the sale of ethyl alcohol by drug stores except upon the written prescription of a physician.

This ordinance is designed to check the heavy traffic in alcohol which has resulted from the provision in the prohibition law making it possible to secure alcohol upon an affidavit that it was intended for external use. Druggists and officers have been aware that men have not hesitated to perjure themselves in order to secure the alcohol for internal use and the big majority of cases of intoxication have resulted from this traffic. The druggists have complained that they have been unable to distinguish between those who want the alcohol for legitimate purposes and those who want it for unlawful purposes. Therefore, they asked the ordinance for their own protection and it was passed unanimously.

The committee appointed a week ago to investigate the matter of securing more water for patrons during the summer months without extra charge reported that the season is too far advanced to put any new plan into effect. The old plan, adopted by the commission last year, of having patrons contract to pay as much as they did the year preceding and receive a pro rata of the surplus water is still in effect.

Liquor Shipments Greatest in June.
Baker, July 12.—The greatest gain in liquor shipments into Baker county in any one month since the prohibition law went into effect, was made in the month of June, according to an enumeration of liquor affidavits on file in the county clerk's office this morning. The importation of beer more than doubled the amount shipped in during May while spirituous liquors brought into the county through legal channels totalled nearly 500 quarts more than the May aggregate.

In all, 349 shipments of beer were received in June, making 8,736 quarts, as compared to the 3,938 quarts received in May. Spirituous and vinous liquors for June reached 1,338 quarts in 669 shipments, while in May 1,047 quarts were brought into the county.

Stanfield Buys Part of Malheur Company.
Ontario, July 13.—Robert N. Stanfield of Stanfield, has purchased the interest of Harry Anderson in the Malheur Livestock & Land company. The consideration is said to be \$80,000. This makes the largest transaction of the kind since Monti B. Gwinn of Boise sold his interest last year in the company to P. H. O'Neil & Sons of San Francisco.
The Malheur Livestock and Land company's holdings comprise probably 18,000 acres of land, including the Anderson & Gwinn ranch west of Ontario, the Butterfield ranch of 440 acres, the Crowley ranch of 3500 acres, other ranches and range, and 40,000 head of sheep, most of which are full bloods. Its wool clip this year sold for \$90,000.

Paralysis Campaign Now at Standstill.
Baker, July 13.—Any further steps in the infantile paralysis situation to be taken locally depend on the reply from State Health Officer Roberg, to a letter written by City Health Officer J. W. Huff. Dr. Huff expects an answer before the end of the week.
Supplanting the plan outlined by Dr. Roberg's letter, read at the city commissioners' meeting Tuesday, Dr. Huff's idea is that all the examining necessary to prevent infected children coming into the state by train, and spreading the disease through Oregon, could be done at three points, Huntington, Ontario and Ashland. In this way, he believes, incoming passengers would have to submit only to one examination, while the expense, he says, would be less than one-tenth of that which would be necessary under the plan at first advised.
