Easy to Hypnotize Even the Kaiser

Cambridge, Mass., July 20.—"I have never yet found a person whom I could not successfully hypnotize within a very short time," declared Prof. Huga Muensterberg of Harvard today in a lecture on psychology before the Harvard summer school. The Professor did not even except his friend, Kaiser Wilhelm. Prof. Muensterberg added:

"Hypnotism presents a vast field for the expert. It is so easy to produce the hypnotic trance that any one can do it on others, but it is exceedingly dangerous when thoughtlessly or ignorantly used. It is simply a case of increasing the suggestibility of the mind, and it can be used in medicine to cure the morphine fiend, the alcohol fiend and all who have abnormal desires. Often only a slight hypnosis is necessary to effect a cure for nervous disorders.

"Medicine, equally with law is to be the food for the psychologist of the future. Every mental train can be measured exactly by almost perfect standards. The old methods are obsolete and the whole science of diagnosis has been carried into the field of experiment. Psycho-analysis has a great future."
