

# ETERNAL AS THE HILLS

All doors, window frames and sash, gates, grills and so forth will be of non-rusting bronze or copper. The interior of the building will be faced with finest Alaskan marble.

Every ounce of material entering into the La Grande Community Mausoleum will be enduring and durable. It will be impossible to erect a building more permanent than this. This building will be as lasting as the Pyramids, as eternal as the hills.
