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EXPERIENCE IN TRAINING CAMP

LYTTON IVANHOE WAS IN SAN FRANCISCO PARADE

But His Company Had Passed Place When Bomb Exploded.

Lytton Ivanhoe, who is in a military branch training camp at Monterey, Cal., in a letter to his mother, School Superintendent A. E. Ivanhoe, says in part:

"Intended to write you last Saturday evening, but we went up to San Francisco that day to take part in the Preparedness parade, so I got no chance. Understand we made quite a showing in the parade, being the only body under arms in the whole outfit. The bomb of the anarchist or crank was not exploded until about 10 or 15 minutes after our division had completely passed, so no damage was done to our ranks. It was a terrible outrage, as you have no doubt learned through the newspapers. They have a number of suspects in jail now, and I hope the real criminal is among those apprehended.

"Well, down here at this camp they are certainly working the stuffing out of us, but we are being given a very thorough course of training in the fine art of war which may some day prove of benefit to the nation. One certainly learns how little we really know about army matters by attending one of these camps, and everyone will leave here broadened in many ways. We get up at 5:45 a. m., and there is always something to do in the way of drills, etc., until evening, and quite often a lecture is provided for the night. All in all, we have a very busy time of it, but every moment is interesting. The meals are very good, and sleeping under canvas, with lots of outdoor work in the daytime, is a good tonic for an office man as anyone will admit. In addition, we all know the value of the training we are receiving, which might one day prove a rather valuable asset in either business or national service. If we had more men attending camps of this character, we would have considerably less cause to fear any foreign peril, as our own readiness to meet any crisis would insure us a lasting peace, and prevent us from becoming entangled in any disastrous war."

Notice of Proposed Sewer Construction.

Notice is hereby given to all concerned that the Commission of the City of La Grande, Oregon, deems it expedient and proposes to improve Section 6 of Sewer District No. 1 of the City of La Grande, Oregon, by constructing therein a sanitary sewer and assessing the cost thereof to the property in said district affected by and to be benefited by said proposed improvement and upon which an assessment is to be levied for the construction of such sewer has made and filed in writing its report and the Commission has examined, acted upon, and adopted the same: That the boundaries of the district proposed to be so improved are as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the center of the intersection of Grandy avenue in Grandy's second addition to the town of La Grande, Union county, Oregon, and Cedar street in said addition, and running thence north along the center line of Cedar street in the center of the intersection of Cedar street and Palmer avenue in said Grandy's second addition; thence west along the center line of said Palmer avenue to the center of the intersection of said Palmer avenue and Oak street in said addition; thence south along the center line of Oak street to the center of the intersection of said Oak street and Grandy avenue in said addition; and thence east along the center line of said Grandy avenue to the place of beginning.

That the construction of such sanitary sewer is to be made in accordance with and under the plans and specifications adopted by the Commission of the City of La Grande, therefor on the 28th day of June, 1916, and the said proposed improvements, generally, are to be as follows, to-wit: The construction of a vitrified 8-inch sanitary sewer from the center of Palmer avenue along the center of the alley in block 8 of Grandy's second addition to the town of La Grande, Oregon, to the center of Grandy avenue in said addition and there connecting with the present sanitary sewer, and making all necessary excavations and fills for such construction: That the Commission of the City of La Grande, Oregon, will meet at 7:30 o'clock p. m. Wednesday the 16th day of August, 1916, at the Commission room in the City building in La Grande, Oregon, and hear and determine all objections, remonstrances and claims of grievance of any person interested in such proposed improvement or the property affected thereby and that all objections, remonstrances and claims of grievance must be filed in writing with the recorder of the city before the time set for such hearing.
