#### The Clown.

Victor Moore, the celebrated comedian who immortalized "Chimmie Fadden," will be seen at the Arcade Friday and Saturday in the thrilling photodrama of "The Clown," a Lasky Photoplay on the Paramount program, written especially for him by Marian Fairfax, the distinguished dramatist, and produced under the personal direction of William C.
