Sherry's Today Only. Popular Novel Now Photoplay. There was a time when the writings of H. Rider Haggard had the effect of creating a positive mania among readers of fiction, and right

up to the circulation of his last work his novels sold into the million copies, translated into many languages and read around the world.

The famous author of "She" gained great riches through his imaginative genius and his talent for hitching his novel fancies together in fascinating narrative form. Everything he wrote was eagerly snapped up and read with absorbing interest by devotees of fiction.
