Asserts President's Policy of Safety First Meant "Duty Last, Honor Last and Courage Last"

Lewiston, Me., Aug. 31.—Progressives and Republicans united tonight to greet Roosevelt, who delivered his first campaign speech here for Hughes. He devoted his address largely to an attack on the administration and criticism of hyphenism. He declared that despite the fact that we had war with Spain under McKinley, and peace with Mexico under Wilson, the Mexicans had killed more Americans than the Spaniards did during the war with Spain. He charged the taking of Vera Cruz was war, war ignominiously abandoned, and asserted Wilson's "safety first" means duty last, honor last and courage last.
