**CLEAVER WILL
SEEK A TOGA**

PROHIBITION PARTY TO HAVE
CANDIDATE.
Congressional Seat Will Be Sought by
Imbler Orchardist.

George L. Cleaver, Imbler orchard-
ist, has consented to qualify for the
congressional ticket of the Prohibition
party. The district Prohibition
convention held in La Grande last
June, offered this part of the ticket to
Mr. Cleaver but he refused it—the
place was held open until now, when
Mr. Cleaver's acceptance of the offer,
fills out the congressional section of
the Prohibition ticket. His papers
were sent in for filing this week.
Concerning this matter Mr. Cleaver
announces:

"I accepted the Prohibition nomina-
tion in 1912 without protest and re-
ceived 1800 votes. I made no cam-
paign.

"I accepted the nomination in 1914
under protest because I did not want
it. During a two-weeks' campaign
I gathered up 16,000 votes.

when I refused to take the task, and

"The pressure has been so strong
for the last two weeks on the part of
the Prohis and Democrats who are
unwilling to support the Republican

will make a campaign but the Nation-
al committee is giving most of its ef-
forts to the special train now ap-

proaching Oregon with J. Frank Han-
ley and Mr. Landrith, National ticket
leaders."

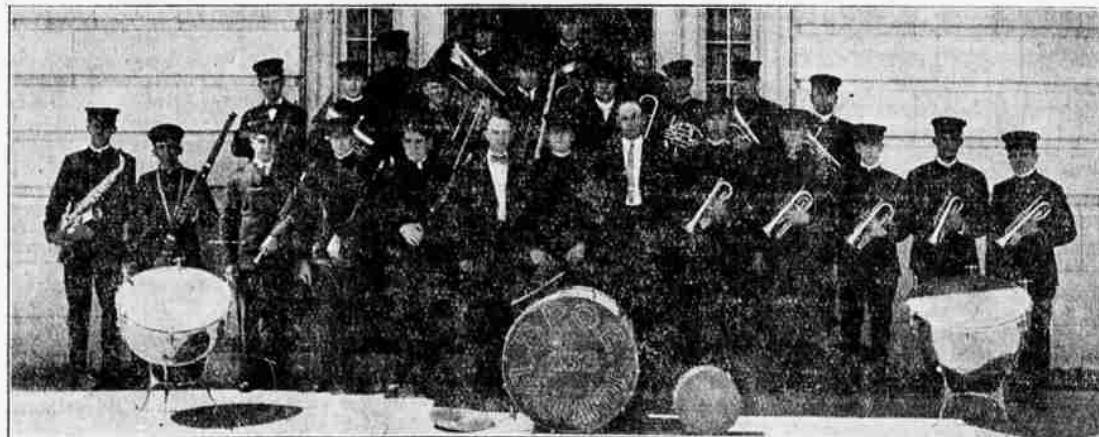
