GUM SENT TO GUARDSMEN

Other Home Comforts Sent New Yorkers on Border.

New York, Sept. 8.—The men of the Seventy-first Regiment, New National Guard, may be far from Broadway, but they are not without many of the comforts of home, as shown by the following list of things shipped to McAllen, Tex., recently by the American Red Cross:

Three hundred and fifty-eight pounds naphthalene flakes and thousands of muslin bags and atomizers to be used as a protection against vermin; drugs, barber supplies, goggles, flypaper, absorbent and non-absorbent cotton, bandages, powdered and malted milk.

Six large packing cases of books, magazines, chocolate, chewing gum, evaporated cream, tobacco, cigarettes, comfort bags, playing cards, etc., were sent to the Connecticut troops at Nogales, Ariz., and 65 cases of food-stuffs and comforts were dispatched to the Massachusetts troops at El Paso.

A shipment of standard hospital supplies was made to a local hospital in Brownsville, Tex., and a number of cases of useful comforts were sent to Mrs. Frederick Funston for distribution at San Antonio.

During the week over \$2000 worth of absorbent cotton, hospital garments rubber goods went to the Russian Red Cross. A similar amount was sent to the Italian Red Cross, and a large ambulance was forwarded to Genoa for the first British ambulance unit for Italy.
