EVANGELIST HEARD AGAIN

REVIVAL MEETINGS AT BAPTIST CHURCH GROW.

Interesting Discussion Last Evening Heard by Many.

Evangelist Marshall spoke last night on the subject, "Stoning of Jesus." He said, in part:

"Jesus Christ has always been the world's benefactor, the sinners' friend. Blind men were given their sight; leprous men were made clean; outcast women were purified. Why stone Him? When the Jews gathered stones to hurl at Him, Jesus turned to them and said: 'For which of my works do ye stone me?' May I ask you why this opposition? Civilization's greatest debt is to the Man of Galilee. Education owes its privilege and progress to Him. Our country, its very foundations, were laid through faith in Him.

"The home has been touched by His power and love; womanhood has been uplifted; the cradle has been holier, motherhood grander, because of the immaculate teaching of Jesus. Why stone Him with doubt and disbelief? Why stone Him by questioning His deity? Why gather stones against Him because the crowd does it?"

Publicity of an Arrest Hurts More Than Payment of a Fine

As a force for the uplifting of morals and the prevention of crime the country newspaper editor stands head and shoulders above the most efficient police force that can be assembled in any community.

Publicity—that one word—explains it all.

Little does the offender object to paying the small fine that is imposed in a police court. Little does he mind his friends knowing that he has stepped momentarily out of the straight and narrow path.

But after the court proceedings his steps invariably lead to the local newspaper office. Cornering the editor in some remote part of the sanctum, a conversation something like this follows:

"I guess you heard that they pulled me last night. I forgot myself wouldn't have had it happen for the world. It doesn't make so much difference about myself, but just for the sake of my wife and children and would do me the little personal favor of leaving it out. You know I have other people I wanted to ask if you always been a steady subscriber and always use a want ad in your paper when I need anything, and I just thought that maybe you could leave this out this time. It won't ever happen again, you can bet on that, and this is the only time I'll ask you."

Here is a true story of a little southern city: A leading attorney was arrested for gambling. He didn't mind paying the small fine, but immediately after court he entered the newspaper office and said: "I'd rather have my right arm cut off than have my name go in the paper."

He meant it too. Petty crime would increase a hundredfold were it not for the horror of publicity.

Whether or not it is better to leave such items out or to print them is a problem for each individual editor to decide. There are good arguments on both sides. But nevertheless the editor is the greatest preventive for crime that any town has.

New President of the Argentine Won't Be a Social Success.

Buenos Aires, August 15--(By Mail) Hipolito Irigoyen, who will become President of Argentina on October 12, my prove to be a political success but there is no indication that he will be a success socially. The Argentinians expect their presidents elect, their presidents and ex-presidents to show themselves in aristocratic circles, to give big balls and receptions and generally add to the gaiety of the capital. President-Elect Irigoyen has been a terrible disappointment in this respect. But for one short visit to Buenos Aires in July, he has remained shut up like a hermit in his ranch house in the country ever since his election. The people are anxious to see him. Pictures of him have been printed but everyone knows they are fakes because there isn't a picture of Irigoyen in existence. The new president's friends excuse him on the ground that he is a prey to a terrible anxiety at the idea of becoming president. He is said to believe that South America, including his own country, will face a tremendous financial crisis when the war ends and to fear that he will be considered a failure. As he is Argentina's first radical president, it would be a party as well as a personal calamity to him.

Club to Plant 325,000 Trout Fry.

Estacada, Ore., Sept. 13.—When Master Fish Warden Clanton announced yesterday that the fish and game commission had no funds with which to distribute hundreds of thousands of trout fry, the Estacada Rod and Gun club stepped into the breach.

The club members will release 125,000 Eastern brook trout fry in the Clackamas river reservoirs at Estacada and Cazadero at once and 200,000 rainbow trout fry measuring from one to four inches in length will be planted in the Clackamas river. The fry must be planted without delay or they will die and each member of the club plans to take a hand to expedite the work.
