**Albany to Have Water System.**  
That Albany is to have a new water system is evidenced by the receipt at the office of the state engineer of an application for permission to install a system which is to cost \$226,000.

It is proposed to pipe the water from Roaring creek, a distance of 23 miles, and the supply will be three cubic feet a second.
