Managers of retail establishments devote a big part of their time each day to keeping abreast of the ever-changing markets.

Sugar and flour are the most flea-like of any, for it is almost impossible to put one's finger on the right figure, so often do they change.

Sugar advanced this morning to the point where cash prices command \$8.80 and the 30-day time figure 40 cents more than that. Ground cherries, watermelons and cantaloupes are some of the foodstuffs rapidly dwindling away from the every-day sales shelves.
