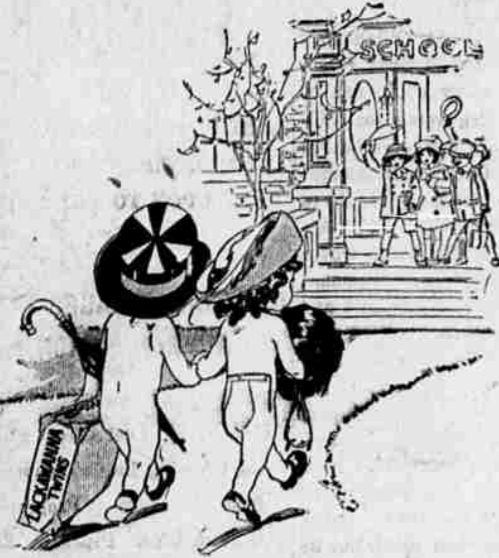

**Standards Bother Commerce.**  
New York, Oct. 27.—(Special)—The business of establishing and enforcing proper standards is somewhat new to American commerce. However, it is a necessity that has been recognized by the Federal Government, through its Bureau of Standards, which covers a very broad field of activity. One of the recent moves on the part of a Government department seeks to establish official and scientifically accurate standards for gasoline. The Agricultural Department has been moving along the line of uniformity of grades in wheat, cotton and other grains. Honest weights and measures have occupied the serious consideration of the authorities of large cities, and millions of dollars have been thereby saved to the consumer. A great deal of legislation has been appearing of late years, fixing the size of barrels, buckets, baskets, bottles and other containers in order to make it a little plainer than formerly just what quantity the consumer is entitled to receive. During Mayor Gaynor's administration New York short-weight and false-scales merchants were given many severe shocks. The results were salutary, and a consistent policy of following them up was inaugurated to the everlasting benefit of the consumers.

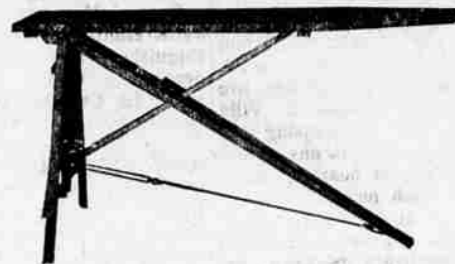
