Contests Puts New Life in the School

Grades and High School Attack Spelling and Arithmetic with Vigor and Show Good Progress.

Even spelling and multiplication tables may be made vital subjects, pulsating with interest, if they are approached through the avenue of contests. This has been again brought to attention by means of the contests in the grades and in the high school of La Grande.

The first event of this sort was the spelling contest in which all pupils above the sixth grade participated. A list of one hundred words was made out by Superintendent McCullough and given by his teacher to the grade and high school pupils. In high school enthusiasm ran especially high for these students did not wish to be excelled by grade pupils. The averages from the various schools was as follows:

High School	87 per cent.
Riveria	85 per cent.
Central	83 per cent.
Greenwood	82.5 per cent.

The arithmetic contest was based upon the multiplication tables. All grades above the fourth wrote all the tables. Grades one and two wrote only tables of ones and twos. A queer coincidence of the contest was that the three schools made practically the same average. The time required by the pupils was noted and this, together with the accuracy appears in the following table:
