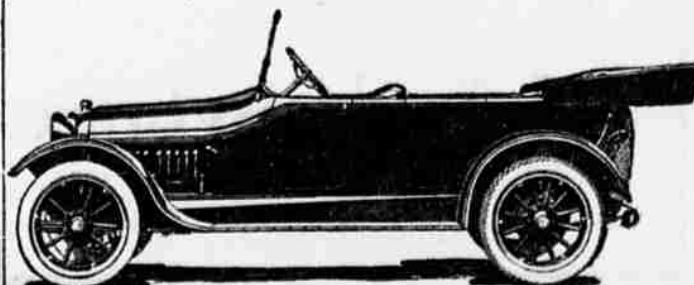

THE CANDY CORNER.

L OLLYPOPS.—What are schooldays without lollipops? And if lollipops are so essential, why not have their children's craving for sweets satisfied with a pure, home made candy?

Butter Scotch.—One-quarter pound of butter, one pound of sugar, one cupful of water. Boil till crisp.

Lemon Drops.—Substitute orange for lemon in this recipe if you wish to make orange drops.

Meringue Kisses.—Beat the whites of four eggs until quite stiff, add pinch of salt, teaspoonful of flavoring.

Coconut Candy.—One and one-half cupfuls of sugar, one-half cupful of milk, one teaspoonful of butter.

Various Puddings.

LEMON PUDDING.—Four three and one-half cupfuls hot milk over two cupfuls breadcrumbs. Beat yolks of two eggs with a milk sugar and add to the bread and milk grated rind of a lemon. Bake one-half hour.

Date Pudding For Sunday Night's Supper.—Two cupfuls of milk, half a cupful of sugar, two tablespoonfuls of flour, half a cupful of dates stoned and cut in pieces, one egg. Cook milk, sugar, flour and yolk of egg until thick and smooth, then add nuts and dates and, lastly, well beaten whites. Fold in well and serve very cold, with whipped cream.

Foam Sauce: A cupful pulverized sugar, two eggs. Beat sugar and yolks together in a bowl, set in boiling water, stir until hot; then add whites beaten stiff, put a small piece of butter and the flavoring in a dish, pour over them the sugar and eggs just before serving.

Orange Pudding.—Three cupfuls of cold rice, a quart of milk, one-half cupful sugar, one-quarter cupful of chopped suet, an orange, three eggs. The rice is boiled in milk; then the sugar, suet and juice and the grated peel of orange are added; also the well beaten eggs. This must be mixed together thoroughly and then baked in a buttered pudding mold.
