BUTTER PRICES UP ON 2LB ROLL

Wholesale Prices Boosted—Canned Stuff Scarce and 25 Per Cent of Orders Are Filled—Frosts Caught Canneries.

Butter advanced on wholesale lots today to such an extent that it is now no cheaper to buy a two-pound roll. The one-pound roll is not increased in price.

Canned Stuff Higher.

*Standard canned goods have gone up and the reason is clear, once investigated. The Eagle Valley cannery, Utah, California and other like canneries put up about 33 per cent of the usual pack this year due to early frosts. The Eagle Valley plant put up only 25 per cent. Hence wholesalers are lucky if they can fill 25 per cent of their orders—and the general shortage has boosted the prices. For years corn, tomatoes and beans have sold on a two-for-25 basis but the retailer is compelled by the general rise to sell 15 cents straight now, it is pointed out.

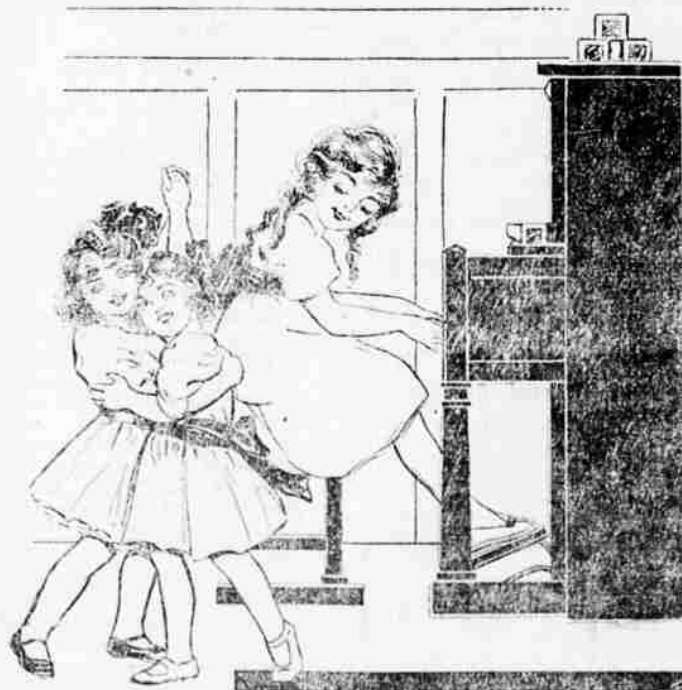
