New York, Nov. 25.—(Special.)—One of the saddest blows that can possibly hit a certain portion of New York is likely to be felt with the coming of the new year. It happens that the night upon which 1917 is ushered in falls on Sunday, and an unsympathetic city administration has declared with more or less positiveness that the festivities which usually come at that time will have to be curtailed or omitted, so far as the restaurants are concerned.
