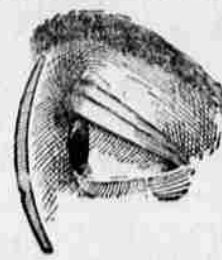

Madison Square Garden, \$4,000,000 Property, on the Auction Block Today

(New York, Dec., 8—United Press)—Madison Square Garden, from the tip of whose dome the whirling Diana once waved greeting to the Statue of Liberty far down the Bay, will go on the auction block today to satisfy a \$2,500,000 mortgage held by the New York Life Insurance company.

The Garden, last vestige of the old Madison Square Garden company financed by J. Pierpont Morgan, Darius O. Mills, James B. Darling and others in 1885, is valued at \$4,000,000 and is the largest single piece of downtown property that can be bought in New York.

The Old Fifth Avenue hotel is gone long since. The Eden Musee too has disappeared; and now the Garden, last and greatest mark of the Madison Square district of generations ago is about to pass. Skyscrapers, notably the Flatiron building and the Metropolitan, have closed in on the old Garden and buried it.

The Garden, scene of innumerable Horse shows, circuses, balls, mass meetings, prizefights and six bicycle races, never has been a financial success. It cost \$4,000,000 to build and the promoters have lost money on it ever since.

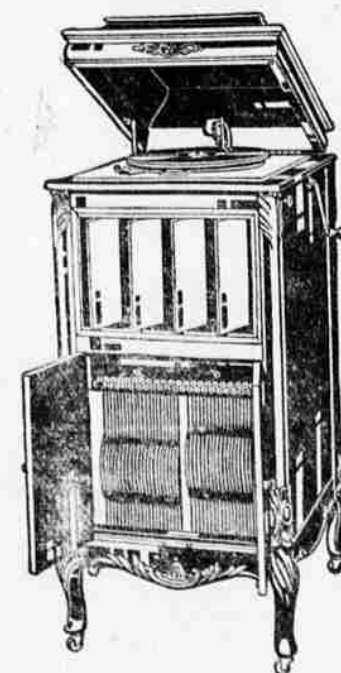
