POTATOES, NANCE O'NEIL



NANCE O'NEIL



INGREDIENTS.

4 large potatoes, 1 egg.
2 tablespoonfuls milk.
1 level tablespoonful butter.
1 level tablespoonful chopped parsley.
Grating of onion.
Salt, pepper.
4 small sausages, parboiled 5 minutes.
Time: Preparation and cooking, 1 1/2 hours.
Number served: 4 persons.



BAKE potatoes until soft. Remove from oven, cut a slice, lengthwise, from each potato; scoop out the inside, preserving the shells. To the potato add milk, butter, seasoning and egg, beaten. Mix all together, refill potato shells, place a sausage in the center of each and bake in a quick, hot oven until sausages and tops of potatoes are brown. A slice of bacon may be substituted for the sausage. These are excellent with poultry or steak and easily prepared.

SHIRLEY MASON SUNDAES

PUT one cupful of brown sugar, one-fourth cupful of water, two teaspoonfuls of lemon juice and one level tablespoonful of butter into a small saucepan. Heat slowly, stirring until sugar melts; then cook gently until syrup will thicken between the fingers when a few drops are chilled in ice water. If a thermometer is used boil sirup to 220° F. Serve vanilla ice cream in small cups or glasses, make a depression in the center of each and fill with the warm chopped walnuts may be added.

HEAT slowly two tumblers of currant jelly until melted. Boil one-half cupful of sugar, one cupful of water, the chipped rind of one lemon and one orange together for eight minutes. Add this to the melted currant jelly. When cool, add the juice of four lemons, two oranges and about one quart of water and strain. Serve in tall glasses two-thirds full of crushed ice. Recipe makes enough for twelve or more.

LITTLE PEPPINA COOKIES



MARY PICKFORD

INGREDIENTS.
1/2 cupful butter.
1/2 cupful sugar, 2 eggs.
1 tablespoonful milk.
1/4 level teaspoonful salt.
1/2 level teaspoonful cinnamon.
Grating of nutmeg.
2 level teaspoonfuls baking powder.
1 cupful seeded raisins, cut small.
1/2 cupful chopped walnuts, grated rind of 1/2 lemon.
1 1/4 cupfuls flour, about.
Time: Preparation, 20 minutes; baking, 15 minutes.
Number served: Recipe makes 50 small cakes.

CREAM butter and sugar. Add salt, spices, lemon rind, baking powder, milk and eggs, beaten without separating. Mix all well together. Add flour, raisins and nuts. Chill in refrigerator. Roll into a thin sheet, cut with a heart shaped cutter, placed on a greased sheet, and bake in a moderate oven. These cookies are especially delicious for afternoon tea. Cakes may be dropped on pan and flattened with a fork instead of rolled. Nuts may be omitted.

(Celery and Oyster Soup)

INGREDIENTS
2 cupfuls celery, cut small.
1 quart water.
1 quart milk.
12 large oysters.
4 level tablespoonfuls of flour.
2 level tablespoonfuls of butter.
Salt, pepper.
Few drops onion juice.
Time: Preparation and cooking, 45 minutes.
Number served: 6 persons.



ADD water to the celery, cook until tender, then add the milk. Melt butter, add flour and mix. Add a spoonful of hot soup and mix until smooth. Now add this thickening to the soup and cook slowly, stirring, until whole is smooth and creamy. Add seasoning, oysters; cook a moment longer; serve at once. A delicious soup; also good without the oysters. For special occasions serve with a spoonful of whipped cream and a few grains of paprika topping each portion.

ABDULLAH SALAD.

PEEL large white grapes. Cut them into halves, removing seeds. Pare tangerines, removing pulp in sections. Mix fruit in equal quantities; season with a very little salt and pepper; add enough olive oil, mixed with a few drops of lemon juice, to cover the fruit. Serve very cold on a bed of crisp lettuce leaves on individual plates. In the center of each portion place a small cream cheese ball, rolled in finely chopped pistachio nuts. Carefully prepared this salad is delicious and the color scheme very lovely, excellent for the company luncheon or dinner. Oranges may be substituted for tangerines.

ANN MURDOCK SANDWICHES

CUT one small bottle pimento olives in thin slices; mix these with one small, fresh cream cheese; moisten with a spoonful of well made mayonnaise. Spread between thin slices of buttered white and brown bread, adding a little cress or fringed lettuce and having one side of the sandwich white and the other brown. Cut in small, fancy shapes. These are very good "party" sandwiches, as they are both appetizing and satisfying.

CRAB FLAKES, LE GUERE

INGREDIENTS.

2 cupfuls crab flakes (1 pound).
2 level tablespoonfuls of butter.
2 level tablespoonfuls of flour.
1 cupful milk.
1/2 cupful cream.
Salt, paprika.
1 egg, hard cooked.
Time: Preparation and cooking, 25 minutes.
Number served: 4-6 persons.



MELT the butter in the chafing dish, add flour and mix. Add milk and cream and cook slowly, stirring until the sauce is smooth and thick; add seasoning and yolk of egg rubbed to a paste with a spoonful of sauce. Now add the crab flakes and cook until heated through. Serve at once on thin rounds of buttered toast.
Note.—If good shrimps are available a few may be added to the crab flakes just before serving. Crab meat may be obtained from almost any first class fish dealer.

Good Land Drainage Means Better Crops

State Drainage Association Plans Aggressive Campaign to Reclaim Wet Lands.

Corvallis, Ore., Jan. 26.—(Special)—The Oregon State Drainage association has approved a plan to print the biennial reports and stenographic records of meetings held last two years and thus give other persons interested in better drainage an opportunity to learn something of the methods and results of drainage on wet lands and alkaline irrigated lands. "The drainage sentiment is growing very fast now, and calls for assistance in planning and carrying on the work are greater than at any time heretofore," says W. L. Powers, head of irrigation and drainage work at the agricultural college and secretary of the state association. "More real progress was made at the recent meeting held here than at any previous meeting."

The general movement for agricultural lime has developed the fact that drainage is indispensable to the use of agricultural lime and that any lime movement to succeed must first, prepare the way by suitable drainage. The extent of general interest is seen in the fact that the 5000 edition of the college bulletin on drainage issued last July is just about exhausted.

The state association is comprised of six districts with directors as follows: Wm. Hanley of Burns, Central Oregon; A. A. Mehaffey of Klamath Falls, Walter M. Pierce of La Grande, B. Beals of Tillamook, William Egan of Gervais, T. G. Smith of Echo. C. C. Chapman is director at large. The officers are F. N. Edwards of Monroe, president; W. L. Powers of Corvallis, secretary, and J. E. Larson of Corvallis, chairman program committee.
