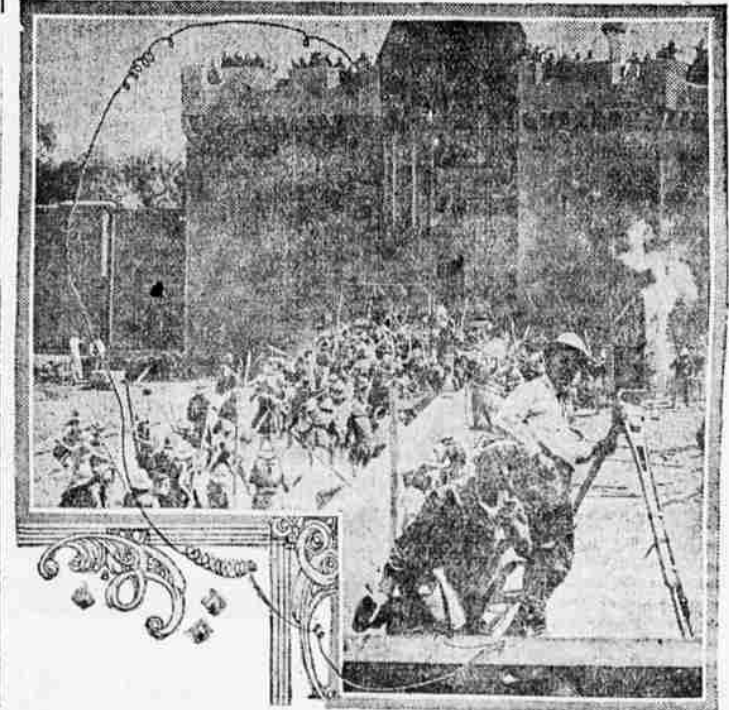

Telephones Direct Motion Picture Army

Cecil B. DeMille In Producing Great Battle Scenes For Story of Joan of Arc, With Geraldine Farrar as Star, Resorts to Latest Methods



For the first time in the history of motion picture making an army of two thousand photoplay actors on horseback and afoot was directed, in scenes representing the great French battle of Patay, by a system of telephones installed by Cecil B. De Mille, producer of the picture based on the story of Joan of Arc.

The star of the production is Geraldine Farrar, famous Metropolitan prima donna, who participated in the midst of the stirring battle scenes. Usually it is a matter of more than a week to obtain artistic battle scenes for the motion picture camera. Mr. De Mille, forever facing the problem of making valuable use of the precious time of Miss Farrar, took less than half that space of time for the Joan of Arc production by installing on the two mile battlefield a system of telephone communication between himself and assistants.
