39TH SECTION OF AMERICAN AMBULANCE GOES TO FRENCH FRONT

Paris, Feb. 18.—(By Mail)—A new, the 39th section of the American Ambulance Field Service left Paris for the front today, making 300 American ambulances and a similar number of young American men who are suffering French wounded behind the firing lines.

Before the end of March 450 American ambulances and drivers will be at the disposal of the French army, it was learned today. One hundred and fifty additional machines have been ordered, and men, mostly college students, have already enlisted to have charge of the new equipment.
