Feeder For Motherless Litter Of Pigs. The rather difficult problem of feeding a little of little pigs whose mother has died, has been largely solved by an Oregon man who has devised an ingenious feeder consisting of a strong wooden rack which holds nine long-neck bottles in a row a few inches above the ground, with the mouth of each pointing downward as a slight angle. Each bottle is provided with a substantial rubber nipple held securely in place by a clamp so that a too eager little pig cannot pull it off. When the bottles to be filled they are set upright by turning the rack over on its side.—From the March Popular Mechanics Magazine.

Likewise, most critics hopped into the panning brigade and gave the match a broadside or so. The result was that Promoter Grant Hugh Brown decided Al wouldn't do as an opener for his club in the garden and switched over to Jack Dillon when he had the chance. Al McCoy has been laughed at so unmercifully since he luckily dropped George Chip in a single punch and came into Chip's alleged middle-

weight title that it behooves some one to slip in a word of commendation for him. McCoy is the toughest middleweight who has shown his wares in a New York ring for many a day. Dillon hit him with everything he had in stock and he didn't more than make the Brooklyn boy blink. They were crushing blows that most of the heavyweights would have fallen under. Al took them and at the end of the bout he was just as fresh as Dillon. Had the bout gone ten rounds longer it is very doubtful if Dillon would have been able to wear down his lighter opponent, and if it had been one of the old-time fortyfive round affairs McCoy might have been the winner, although he was pitted against one of the toughest boys who ever stepped through the ropes of a ring. McCoy didn't hit Dillon hard enough for the Indiana scrapper to really feel the effects of it. His heavy right hand has been greatly overrated. But McCoy's style is a hard one to fathom. He is very hard to hit and he is very dangerous. He can keep on and on where other boxers would falter and fade away. McCoy isn't a champion, but he stopped the man who was credited with being a champion and he fell heir to the title. GIRL ROOKIES DELVE DEEP INTO THE WAR BUSINESS

Washington, March 12.—(United Press)—Sweet girl graduates of the First National Service School, Women's Section of the Navy League will delve deep into the intricacies of warfare when they go into their second encampment here at Chevy Chase April 16.

Post graduate companies have been organized for the encampment this year and those who served in 1916 are eligible for places. They will take up a higher course of dietetics, camp cookery, map reading, motor car driving, repairing, bicycling, advanced signalling, plain and wireless telegraphy. Former students must have applied for membership in these companies before March 10th. The regular course, mostly for girl rookies, still have a number of vacancies but officers in charge of the encampment declare it will be even more successful than last year. Camp will open April 16 and will be broken May 26, giving forty whole days of military training. A Plattsburgh idea will be put into effect this time, the red, white and blue system. By this plan those women who attended but one course last year will wear red and white service stripes, while those who took up two courses are entitled to the coveted red, white and blue stripes.

Plans for the second encampment are practically complete. Women have been enrolled from Baltimore, Philadelphia, New York, Chicago and Boston as well as many Southern cities. Powder puffs and "party" dresses will be replaced by khaki and drab smockers while these women learn soldiering. A large building will be added to the equipment this year where lectures may be held in inclement weather. Captain E. B. Creevy, who has returned from Haiti, will have charge of laying out the camp and Mrs. Hugh L. Scott, wife of the Chief of Staff of the Army, will head the camp committee.
