Colombia Is To Be Paid \$25,000,000

Washington, March 14.—(United Press)—The Senate Foreign Relations committee reported the Colombian treaty authorizing payment of \$25,000,000 to Colombia. It added a phrase declaring the United States' right in the Panama Canal zone was unquestionable. It goes to the Senate tomorrow. President Wilson is scheduled to urge immediate ratification.

Former Brakeman of O.-W. R. & N. Starts Action to Recover \$20,000 for Injuries Sustained in Fall From Car

Pendleton, Or., March 14.—Alleging injuries while employed by the O.-W. R. & N., and through the company's negligence, J. B. Dungan, formerly brakeman, has brought suit in the circuit court for \$20,000 damages. The accident is alleged to have happened at North Powder last June. He was thrown from a freight car and sustained injuries that put him in hospital five weeks. He alleges he never will be able to do heavy work again.
