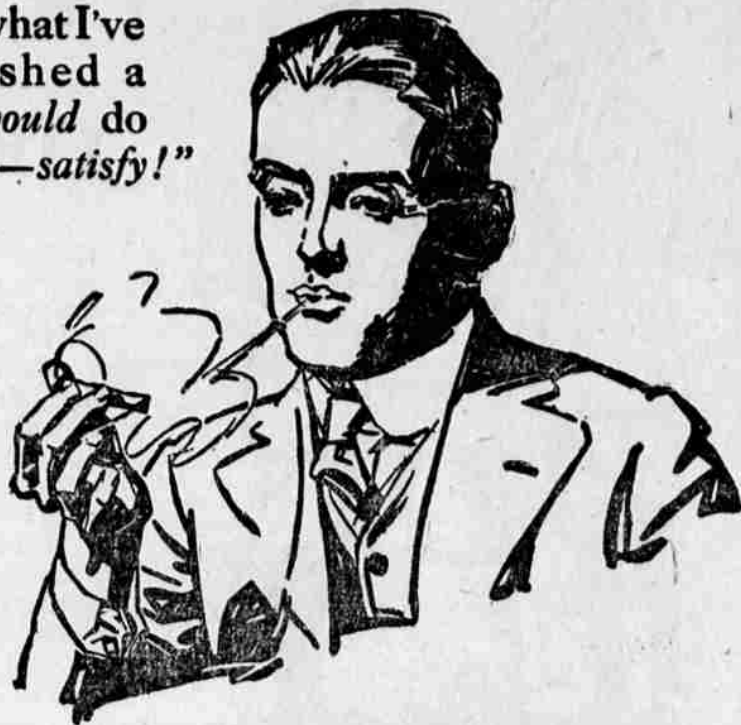

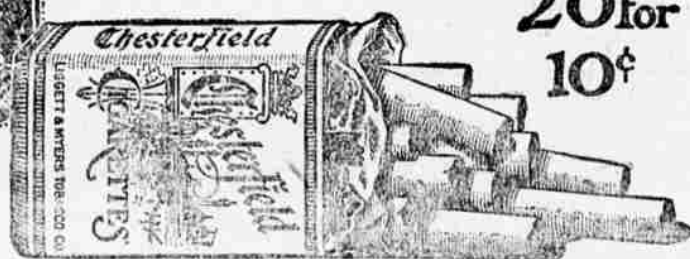

HOUSEHOLD CARES KEEP MEN OUT OF JAIL, PRISON WARDEN SAYS

Salem, Ore., March 27.—(By United Press)—Household cares keep men out of jail, in the opinion of Charles A. Murphy, warden of Oregon state prison today. Husband who are responsible for the wife and kiddies have less time to become criminals than unmarried men, in his belief.

Central Powers' Subjects Make Rush To Leave China

Tokio, March 1.—(By Mail)—Availing themselves of what may be their last opportunity to cross the Pacific until the end of the war, sixty subjects of the Central Powers took passage on the liner China, due at San Francisco. All but four boarded the

vessel at Shanghai.

Since early in the war Teuton subjects have been able to leave China only aboard American steamers and the possibility that the China might be the last American liner to leave Chinese ports before war between Germany and the United States and possibly war between China and Germany, caused a record number of

Germans, Austrians, Turks and Bulgarians to take passage at Shanghai.
