NOT TO LAY ROCK BASE.

Counties Will Be Required Merely to Grade and Drain State Highways.

Salem, Ore., April 25.—(Special)—Herbert Nunn, the recently appointed state highway engineer, is sending a statement to all the county judges in the state correcting the impression which has gotten out that under the \$6,000,000 road bonding act it would be necessary for the counties to lay the rock base before the state would put on the hard wearing surface.

It is made clear in Mr. Nunn's statement that the counties will not be required to build the base. The highway engineer's letter is as follows:

"The Oregon state highway commission in session on April 10, decided on account of the general misunderstanding in regard to the preparation of grades for hardsurfacing under the \$6,000,000 bonding act, to

issue the following statement:

"That counties will be required to grade and drain all highways to be paved by the state; that such grading and drainage must be approved by the state highway engineer's office, and in accordance with the standards required by that office; that counties will not be required to build a base for hardsurfacing under the \$6,000,000 bonding act; that the base will be built by the state, and that the base is considered a part of the hardsurfacing."

"Any county may upon application receive a copy of our general instructions and standards for the preparation of such highways."

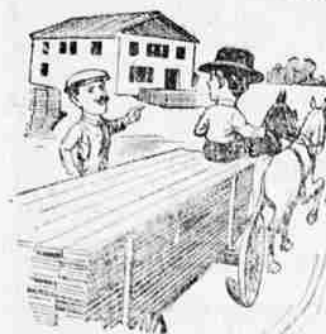

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Grange Opposes \$6,000,000 Bonds

BLUE MOUNTAIN GRANGE NO. 345 ADOPTS RESOLUTIONS DECLARING OPPOSITION

We, the members of Blue Mountain Grange No. 345, are opposed to the \$6,000,000 bond issue.

First: We believe the issuing of bonds to be the most expensive method of road building and the sum named would not be sufficient to pave only a small part of the roads specified, and it is but an entering wedge for many millions of bonds to follow.

Second: The \$6,000,000 road bond issue is not to be used in building roads, but in paving roads that the counties must grade, drain and bridge.

Third: The proposed roads are principally tourists roads paralleling rivers and railroads.

Fourth: The immense issues of bonds on the market makes the sales dull and there is absolutely no restrictions governing the sale of these bonds. But they can be sold at any price satisfactory to the commission.

Fifth: If as proposed the one-fourth mill tax and the present auto tax are taken to pay interest on these bonds. They will be taken from our general road fund which must be replaced, as our market roads must be maintained for all economic and general purposes.

Sixth: Our country is now in war with foreign countries. The termination, expense and burden of which no one can foretell and we consider it unwise to add to that burden the proposed issue of bonds to build sport roads.

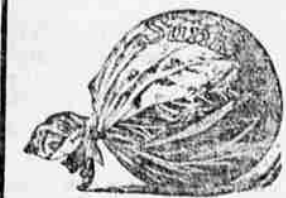
Furthermore, with the call of men to arms and the other needs of our government, and the serious problem confronting the farmers of obtaining help to care for their crops, there will be no available men to build the

proposed road, and with the increasing high cost of building material makes this a proper time to economize in road building as in other ways.
