Potatoes Have Rich Dividends

Oregon Potato Profits Are On Substantial Basis.

We can safely base our profits here on a cost figure of thirty cents a bushel for quality table stock. When catering to the seed trade, however, we must be willing to allow the cost to double, but of course we are paid for the extra outlay.

This year, of course, finds prices

abnormal, but we do not have to base next season's profits on exceptional high years, but on the consistent market conditions open to the quality of potatoes Oregon is able to produce. A profit of \$25 to \$40 an acre is a fair guess at returns.

Oregon potatoes are a resource worthy of the highest protection, which must be brought about through

state potato seed certification and local community efforts toward increasing the demand for them.

The grower must organize to find out definitely that he is on the proper road, through better cultural methods, to obtain superior quality potatoes, which must be marketed to the greatest satisfaction and profit. The consumer will readily co-operate with this move by finding potatoes with shallow eyes and smooth skins, which may be pared with very little waste and all the splendid flavor, which is concentrated near the skin, retained.

Soil fertility is a companion phrase to diversified farming. You can be a potato man and grow one acre as well as grow ten or more. The potato profit comes from running the crop a term of years—not gambling on unprepared soil producing to catch only high priced years. Dairies find the potato crop works in splendidly with good dairy management, as the abundant manure supply provides the humus so essential to good potato soil.

Not only is the potato crop a cash crop, but in addition it has a great value in helping the soil fertility problem in farm management.

Exhibitions Are Community Opportunities.

Exhibitions offer a medium through which communities may really find where they stand in the potato world, as regards type and quality of both seed and table stock. The biggest has now given way to the best as a slogan for price qualifications. A competent judge's attention is held more by quality and the desirable market size, which is medium, than by the plate of the biggest potatoes.

Five potatoes to a plate is enough by which to judge a variety. If the exhibitor has not clearly fixed in his mind the true type, he may feel reasonably safe in selecting the average of the mass of his crop. Uniformity of the contents of the exhibition plate is an essential feature. They must be the same in size, depth, shape, color, texture of skin and number of eyes. Washing potatoes for exhibi-

tion is not as good a plan for cleaning as is brushing. Wrap them in paper if they are to be shipped some distance.

Produce a potato which will make your district one of the first calling points of the potato buyers—not the last.

MUCH FOOD FROM SMALL AREAS

Detailed Discussion by Government Specialists of the Ways in Which a Little Land Is Made to Produce Many Vegetables.

Washington, D. C., May 2.—(Special)—The best methods to follow and the best crops to grow in order to make a small area like a back yard produce the maximum amount of food for the family are discussed in a new publication of the U. S. Department of Agriculture, Farmers' Bulletin 818, The Small Vegetable Garden. In addition to furnishing information in regard to the fundamental principles of gardening, this bulletin describes in detail the culture of all of the common garden plants, and also furnishes a table showing in a concise form the quality of seed needed for each kind of vegetable, the proper way and times to plant, and the material required to produce the crop.

To make a small area produce a large amount of food, the bulletin points out that not only every foot of available space must be utilized, but that late or succession crops must be planted as soon as the earlier plants have been removed. To carry on gardening in this intensive way requires careful planning in advance, and it is recommended that a detailed diagram of the garden be drawn up and the various uses that it is planned to put each portion to, throughout the growing season, be clearly indicated. On this plan the success or failure of the various enterprises should be noted and the plan itself kept as a guide for the following year.

ORGANIZATION OF A MILITARY RAILWAY REGIMENT.

The formation of a military railway regiment to assist the army by the construction and operation of railways in connection with military movements is now being organized under the direction of S. M. Felton, president of the Chicago Great Western at Chicago. The new organization will consist of one company each from the following Chicago railroads: The Illinois Central, the Chicago Great

Western, the Chicago NorthWestern, the Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul, the Chicago, Rock Island & Pacific and the Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe. Several months previous to the declaration of war Mr. Felton, who was appointed consulting engineer and advisor to the chief of engineers of the United States Army at the time of threatened hostilities on the Mexican Border was directed to perfect plans for the formation of the new army unit.

Simultaneously with the entrance of the United States into the war, steps were taken to form the regiment.—Railway Age.
