JUDGE THOMAS H. CRAWFORD'S ADDRESS AT THE FLAG RAISING

Judge Thomas H. Crawford's speech at the O.-W. R. & N. flag raising exercises follows:

Ladies and Gentlemen and Fellow Citizens of LaGrande:

We are living in a wonderful age. An age of research and discovery unparalleled in the history of the past. An age of science and invention when the hidden resources of nature are being harnessed and put to work for the benefit, comfort, happiness and well being of humanity at large. When the hidden, unseen, electric forces of the air are being utilized and controlled by the telegraph, the telephone and the wireless, for communication and intercourse between our people in different and distant parts of our country in a manner but recently dreamed of. When every hamlet, city, town, county, and state from ocean to ocean are connected up and brought into close touch by railroads, the arteries of inland commerce, that carry the life blood of commerce to and from the people of this great Republic. When the oceans are the highways of commerce between states, nations and

continents, free to all of the people by common right, for trade, travel and intercourse.

We are living in a wonderful country. A country dreamed of by the patriots of the past, but never realized until our government was founded. A government of the People, by the People and for the People. Where the legislators who make the laws, the courts that interpret them, and the officers who enforce them from the President down, to the humblest executive officer, serve by the will of the people, and are the servants and not the masters. Where in the eyes of the law there are no favored classes, but laws are made, and enforced for the common good of all of the People. Where the common good of all the people is goal aimed at, and everything inimical to this is contrary to the spirit of our institutions and subject to regulation by laws enacted by the servants of the people. A minimum wage law and a law limiting the hours of employment of female employees was found necessary to the health and well being of the future

mothers of our country, and these laws were enacted, put into force and upheld by the highest courts of our land. A law limiting the hours of work for employees in interstate railway traffic was found necessary to the safety of the traveling public and to the health and well being of such employees and a law was passed by Congress limiting the same to eight hours, and this was put in force and upheld by the Supreme Court of the United States. These are instances of how far our servants may go in making and enforcing laws for the general good of all of the people.

But we are at war with Germany—Why? Congress as the servants of this great people, alone has the power to declare war. In 1914 war broke out between Germany and her allies on the one hand and England and her allies on the other hand. In the course of this war England and her allies interfered with our ocean traffic, took our ships into their ports, retained them for months, confiscated their cargoes, and interfered with our mails, and did us a great amount of property damage, but she did not sink our ships, or murder or destroy the lives of our people, traveling upon the high seas. Germany, on the other hand early in the war, commenced a system of submarine warfare in violation of all rules of international law by torpedoing and sinking freight and passenger vessels, of belligerents and neutrals indiscriminately, without warning, and murdering and drowning our people and other non-combatants. We protested against this course of conduct with all patience and forbearance. After some time Germany agreed to confine her submarine warfare to the rules of international law and not sink merchant and other unarmed ships without warning and removal of passengers and crews to a place of safety. But she has since disregarded her agreements in this regard, and declared her purpose to torpedo and sink without warning all vessels of belligerents and neutrals alike entering certain zones surrounding the English and French coasts, and she has carried this threat into execution and has torpedoed and sunk without warning over seven hundred neutral vessels over one hundred of which were American vessels, thereby drowning and murdering hundreds of American citizens. For months past she has been and still is pursuing this ruthless course and making war upon the American people. Congress has simply declared that a state of war exists between Germany and the United States and authorized the President to take all necessary steps to prosecute the same. We are not making war upon Germany, but Germany is making war upon us, and we are simply going to defend ourselves against that war. We are not at war with the German people, but with the German government, with centralized German militarism, with the kaiser, Von Hindenburg, Von Trippitz and the centralized military oligarchy of Germany. With us this is not a war of conquest. We want no territory. We want no indemnity. We are simply fighting for our rights, for our rights to travel the high seas about our own business and pleasure without molestation from anyone. For American liberty and freedom as against monarchical military despotism. And we shall win, and when we do win, while we shall not attempt to dictate to Germany the kind of government its people shall have, we hope to see her

people after this cruel, uncalled for and unnecessary war, is over, become as free as the United States of America.

That flag as it floats to the breeze one hundred feet in the air, is emblematic of what we have been in the past, what we are now, and what we shall be in the future. It speaks of liberty, the price our forefathers paid for it, and the sacrifices the American people will make to preserve it. It speaks of victory—victory for right and humanity. It speaks of the hopes and aspirations of humanity throughout the entire civilized world. And it waves a welcome to all people to accept liberty and the benefits of that democracy of which it is emblematic.

It is right and proper that you are all here to assist in raising this flag. Your presence here, on this occasion, shows your love of country, your patriotism and your devotion to the flag and what it stands for. It is right and proper that this flag be raised and float over this place, one of the centers of this great railway system. The fact that the employees of this great company have procured this flag, and raised it here today speaks volumes for the patriotism and devotion to the country. Its size and beauty, the magnificent standard supporting it, cut from the giants growing on the Pacific Coast, shipped over this road on three flat cars, and embedded where it stands in solid cement, is a monument to the patriotism of the Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation company and its employees at LaGrande.

We are a nation one hundred million strong, with over two hundred billions in wealth, banded together in the cause of humanity. To this cause,

like our forefathers, we have pledged and do pledge to each other our property, our lives and our sacred honor. That banner will never be lowered in the dust of defeat. So long as the firmament shall stand, so long as the stars shall shine, so long shall that flag, our flag, the Star-Spangled Banner, "waive over the land of the free and the home of the brave."

My friends, let me admonish you, one and all, to uphold by both acts and words, the hands of our President in this great national crisis. Let us remember that the giving of aid and comfort to the enemy, is treason against the United States, and be zealous to suppress it whenever, and wherever, it raises its head. But with all let us constantly remember those of our friends among us whose hearts are bleeding for the suffering of father, mother, brother or sister, back in the fatherland, and not do or say anything that will tend to make their burden heavier. Let us be true to the cause of humanity, and exemplify by our words and by our conduct the truths for which that banner stands, —the right of every human being to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness.

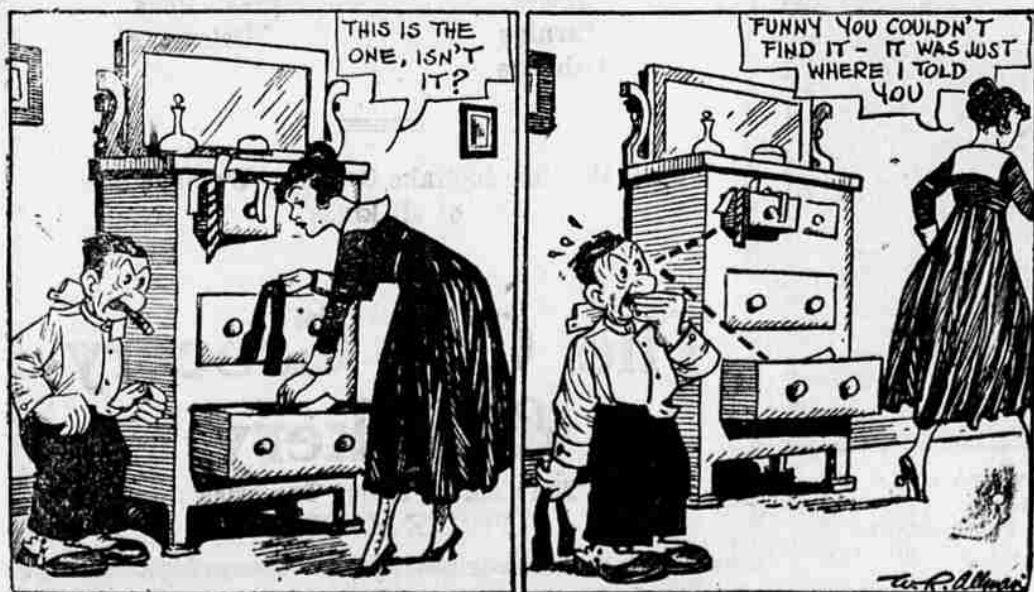

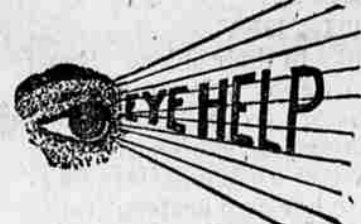
