"TWENTY THOUSAND LEAGUES UNDER THE SEA."

Jules Verne's Great Novel Now in Pictures Will Be Seen at the Arcade Sunday and Monday With Wonderful Scenes of Under Sea Photography.

(Review by W. K. Hollander in the Chicago Daily News.)

About two years ago Chicago gazed with astonishment at the wonders of the sea through the eye of the motion picture camera. The Williamson brothers had brought from the ocean's bottom photographic reproductions of its mysteries and injected a few aquatic episodes of startling and amusing nature for dramatic and

human interest. These were remarkable views obtained with the aid of an ingenious contrivance invented by these men.

Last night the Universal Film company, which acquired the rights to the invention and the services of the inventors, exhibited the latest achievement accomplished with the aid of this modern adjunct to the film industry in a pictorial offering drawn from Jules Verne's "Twenty Thousand Leagues Under the Sea." And a houseful of spectators consisting chiefly of invited guests, was jubilant. They appreciated the privilege of witnessing a film achievement wrought with skill and endurance in advance of other cities and manifested their approval appropriately with hand clapping following brief address by Carl Laemmle's representative.

Is An Enjoyable "Movie."

It is not an every day affair to witness man eating sharks darting directly at you with open jaws as if ready to snap them together with their prey between their teeth or to observe them swimming majestically by, daring and fearless. Even motion pictures do not frequently bear the denizens of the sea in their lair and portray the activities of the ocean's bottom. In these films the nautical gardens adjacent to the Bahama islands have visual reflection. One beholds in addition to the animal life, magnificent vegetation, picturesque coral reefs and sponges breathing with life, imbedded there. From this point of view the entertainment is a photographic marvel.

Capt. Nemo, hero of Jules Verne's drama, recalls the strange career of the Flying Dutchman. Both were sea rovers, one on vengeance bound and the other because he had displeased the Almighty, and neither touched port.

ARMENIA IS CRUSHED IN THE CONTEST OF NATIONAL GIANTS

THE NEW ARMENIA HAS ONLY 600,000 MEN WOMAN AND CHILDREN AS A BASIS TO BUILD ON AFTER THE WAR-POPULATION BEFORE THE WAR WAS 2,000,000,—1,400,000 ARMENIANS KILLED OR DRIVEN INTO THE DESERT

London, April 21—(By Mail)—In the midst of the hurly-burly of war, there are a few persons in London—just a few—giving some thought to what is to become of Armenia after the war. Not Belgium, Serbia nor Poland has suffered as Armenia has suffered. These figures explain: Armenians living in Armenia before the war 2,000,000 Armenians shot, knifed, burned, stoned, drowned and otherwise put to death by the Turks (well authenticated figures) 1,000,000 Armenians unaccounted for from among those driven into the desert 400,000 Armenians in Constantinople, western Asia Minor and Russia 600,000

The new Armenia that is to be reconstructed after the war thus has a basis of only 600,000 men, women and children, unless it be found that some of those driven into the desert have survived. These 600,000 must be brought back into Armenia from the other side of the Russian border and from Constantinople, where they have enjoyed comparative immunity.

The restoration of a nation from such a basis would seem almost hopeless but Armenians in London believe it will be done. Lord Bryce, former ambassador to the United States, who, as he expressed it, has been studying the case of Armenia for forty years, believes it will be done.

"The change in Russia has been a most fortunate thing for Armenia," said Lord Bryce. "The Armenian people may expect more from the Russian people than they obtained from the Russian government in the past."
