OPENING SESSION

Important Feature Is the Fact That Successor to Late Stake President George Stoddard May Be Chosen

The opening session of the Stake Quarterly conference of the L. D. S. (Mormon) church will begin tomorrow morning in the Stake Tabernacle at 10 o'clock. The morning session will be devoted to the Stake Priesthood the afternoon session at 2 o'clock will be a general session of the conference. On Sunday general

sessions will be held at 10:30 a. m. and 2 p. m.

In addition to the usual interest of the conference there is the added feature of importance, not only to members but also of friends of the church, that a successor to late Stake President George Stoddard may be appointed.

In addition to the members in La Grande and environs, large delegations are expected from the other organized branches of the church at Baker, Cove, Imbler, Mt. Glen, Pine Grove and Union. The general public are especially invited to attend the Sunday afternoon session at 2 p. m.
