German Zeppelin Destroyed. London, June 16.—(United Press)—The British airmen destroyed a German Zeppelin at one-thirty yesterday over the North Sea, the Chancellor of Law in the House of Commons announced.
This is the nineteenth Zeppelin to be officially announced destroyed. According to the account of unofficial circles which are apparently reliable the London Times makes the assertion that this is really the thirty-fifth German dirigible destroyed.
