## Myrtle Stedman and Wallace Reid at The Arcade Tomorrow

Wallace Reid and Myrtle Stedman, the popular young artists who scored such a pronounced success in the Lasky-Paramount production of "The Prison Without Walls", will be seen at the Arcade, Friday and Saturday in the Morosco-Paramount production "The World Apart," an unusual and exciting story of western life prepared especially for them by Julia Crawford Ivers from the story by George Middleton, and produced under the personal direction of William H. Reid, who complains that the scenario writers lie awake nights devising new methods of getting him killed, has two thrilling fistie encounters in this production, one of them being especially interesting as from a fight for the reels it developed into a real fight and it took the entire force at the Morosco studio to separate the warring factions. The whole incident is so realistic that it is impossible to tell where the picture fight left off and the actual scrap started, but it is all shown on the screen except where the bystanders interposed.
