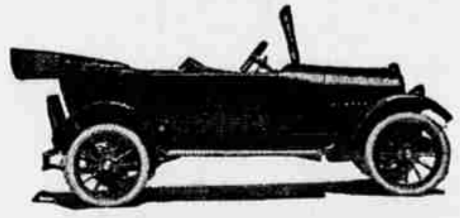
Union News Items
